



The City Centre West to East Link project

The CCWEL active travel route project has been developed over several years with extensive consultation and work has been underway since September 2022 on Queen Street and North St David Street.

After the festive break our work will commence on York Place from Elder Street to Queen Street. This will require a full time closure of York Place to westbound traffic west of Elder Street from January until May. During this time local access will be maintained from Picardy Place to Elder Street, the Bus Station and the St James Quarter and a diversion will be in place for westbound traffic via Abercrombie Place. All traffic exiting Elder Street will be required to turn right to head eastbound on York Place.

If you are located within the closed section (between Elder Street and St David Street) then rear access along Clyde Street Lane will be maintained. However, if you have particular vehicular access concerns please contact us using the email address below to discuss this. Footway access along York Place remains unaffected by the works.

Working with you to reduce disruption

Unfortunately, some disruption and noise is inevitable, but we will work with you to reduce the impact of the works as much as possible. Our plans have been co-ordinated with other ongoing works in the east of Edinburgh and this co-ordination will remain ongoing during the works period.

Safety is our priority

During construction, pedestrian and traffic management measures will be installed and maintained to make sure the works can be carried out safely for everyone, including residents, business and our workforce.
