

Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982

METAL DEALERS

GENERAL LICENCE CONDITIONS

- The licence holder shall comply in all respects and at all times with the requirements of sections 33A to 33E of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 and the requirements of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 (Metal Dealers and Itinerant Metal Dealers)(Verification of Name and Address) Regulations 2016.
- 2. The premises covered by this Licence must be operated in a manner that allows compliance with the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974, the Control of Pollution Act 1974 and all other relevant legislation.
- 3. Any Fire Officer, Police Constable or Authorised Officer of the Council shall be permitted free access to inspect the premises at any time.
- 4. There shall be no burning of materials allowed on the premises.
- 5. All operations shall be carried out so as to ensure no annoyance is caused to neighbouring occupiers by way of noise to the satisfaction of the relevant Executive Director.

GENERAL LICENCE CONDITIONS – ITINERANT METAL DEALERS

- The licence holder shall comply in all respects and at all times with the requirements of sections 33A to 33E of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 and the requirements of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 (Metal Dealers and Itinerant Metal Dealers)(Verification of Name and Address) Regulations 2016.
- 2. The Licensee must at all times when engaged in metal dealing wear or otherwise display the identity card issued with this Licence.
