NOTES

1. The 'project type' column is intended to give a broad indication of the main beneficiaries of the project - ie 'walk'
indicates project will principally benefit people on foot, 'cyc and walk' projects will have significant benefits for people both
walking and cycling, 'cyc' projects will mainly benefit people cycling. It should be noted that it is difficult to precisely
categorise projects and, in accordance with Edinburgh's Street Design Guidance, all projects will seek to benefit people
both walking and cycling, as well meeting other objectives for the streets and paths concerned.

- 2. A map showing scheme locations is under development.
- 3. Most of the projects listed here are being led by the Council's Active Travel Team. Some projects with major active travel impacts (eg George St New Town, tram extension) are not included in this list.
- 4. 'Other work prior to implementing' includes work such as progressing legal orders and land acquisition
- 5. This column shows the Locality or Localities is which a project is located (ie where infrastructure will be built). However projects nearly always have impacts into other Localities. For example the Meadows to Union Canal project is in the South East Locality, but the highest percentage of users is likely to come from the SW Locality.
