Dear Parent or Carer,

NEW PRIMARY SCHOOL – CANAAN LANE

Works to deliver a new primary school on the site of the former Oaklands Care Home on Canaan Lane will commence on Monday 18 November. The new school is expected to be operational from August 2021.

Morgan Sindall are the construction company who have been appointed to build the new primary school. Health and Safety is their top priority and all works will be pre-planned and co-ordinated in a professional manner. They will ensure that any disruption to South Morningside Primary School's classes that will continue to use Deanbank House is kept to a minimum.

The first phase of the project will focus on the demolition of the existing care home building.

In early December, a compound for the demolition and construction works will be formed on the southern part of the park on Canaan Lane that is adjacent to the care home site and currently used by St Peter's RC Primary School. Most of the park will remain available to be used as it is now.

Existing access arrangements to Deanbank House for South Morningside Primary School pupils from Canaan Lane will continue for the first few weeks of the project.

It has been agreed with South Morningside Primary School that after the Christmas holidays pedestrian access to Deanbank House will be via the path that connects Canaan Lane and Falcon Road and runs between the park and the former care home site. The part of the path that runs along the northern boundary of the site to Deanbank House will be upgraded.

Vehicular access to Deanbank House will be in place for emergency and other vehicles. This access will be managed by Morgan Sindall.
