These are traditional Edinburgh practices, often very helpful to those on low or fixed incomes, and can provide great opportunities for visitors to experience the 'real Scotland' within a family or community, and moreover mean that a) visitors show greater respect to the family home they're staying in and b) property owners are careful about who they let to. However, whole property short term lets are having a devastating effect on the price and availability of residential housing in my community. They also negatively impact the character of the neighbourhood, generating large amounts of waste because many visitors want the cache of renting a whole property with a luxury kitchen, but don't want the hassle of actually cooking - this means they are reliant on endless takeaways. This is bad for the environment and bad for the planet as well - food waste increases, and this can attract pests around bin areas.

Tenements in particular are not well suited to this intensive use, as communal stairs create 'noise tunnels' if roller suitcases are being hauled up and down on a daily basis. This impacts on residents' amenity, with particularly negative effects on the elderly, as well as on families' ability to sleep - meaning children may struggle at school and workers suffer in the office because a large party has arrived or departed in the early hours. With the shortage of housing in the city, and the desire to manage tourism rather than endlessly stimulate growth, I believe we need to move away from short term letting and instead provide a mix of accommodation that includes hotels in various price ranges, youth hostels, camping, and home stays with families.
