I will now declare the result of the election in the Ward 8 - Colinton-Fairmilehead. There are 3 Councillors to be elected.
The electorate was 19,454 and the number of ballot papers received was 11,540 giving a percentage turnout of $59.3 \%$. There were 126 rejected ballot papers. The quota of votes for a candidate to be elected was 2,854 .
