0 – Strategic Definition	Set out the project vision and justify strategic need
1 – Preparation and Brief	Define the scope of the project and develop the project outcomes
2 – Concept Design	Concept design prepared to define the interventions including outline proposals and preliminary cost information
3 – Developed Design	Developed design prepared to include coordinated and updated proposals
4 – Technical Design	Technical design prepared to include all required information for construction
5 – Construction	Construction commences according to programme
6 – Handover and Close Out	Construction is complete and the end of works can be formalised
7 – In use	The project is now being used by the community and is to be maintained for 15 years after project construction
