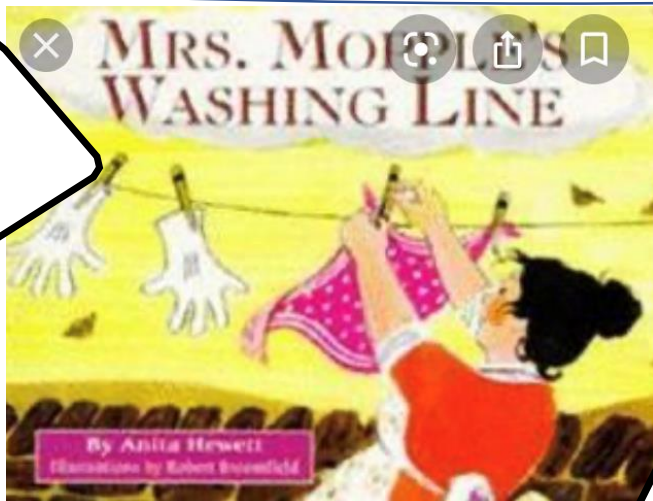


Read '[Mrs Mopple's Washing Line](#)' and talk about the story together. Can you remember all the animals? Can you find them on this page? What did each animal end up wearing?



Draw round your two hands on paper to make the gloves the cow wore then cut them out. Count the fingers and thumbs.

Using the cut out gloves, imagine the cow has a broken horn. Fold one horn (finger) down. How many now? Try some more.

Put an assortment of 10 single socks in a washing basket. Can you match them into pairs? How many pairs?

Handwash some socks in a basin with mild washing up liquid. Hang them on a string, rope or ribbon washing line to dry.

Listen to the [washing song](#). When the socks are dry fold them and put them away.

Make a pretend washing machine from an empty cardboard box. What shape will you make the door? Find some light and heavy items around your house. Which ones can you blow over by blowing through a straw/wafting them with a piece of paper?
