From their first approach to use our hall for a community meal to seeing 50 plus people from very diverse backgrounds sitting down every week to cook and eat together, it has been wonderful to see how the community has embraced what they are attempting.

We are aware their current land usage is very tentative with the Council having an option to recall the land and effectively turf them out. This would be such a loss to our community.

That is why we wish to support their application for community ownership of the land. The security that offers would allow them to develop long term plans both in terms of fundraising support and usage. It would give the community a real boost as it would officially recognise their positive contribution to a very deprived community.

The current arrangement does not do this so is not preferable in the mid to long range.
