THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (TRAFFIC REGULATION; RESTRICTIONS ON WAITING, LOADING AND UNLOADING AND PARKING PLACES)
(VARIATION NO.5), ORDER 2023- TRO/21/03B

The City of Edinburgh Council in exercise of their powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32, 35, 45, 46 and 49 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, (which Act as so amended is hereinafter referred to as "the 1984 Act"), and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby make the following Order:-

This Order may be cited as "The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading and Parking Places) (Variation No. 5), Order 2023" and shall come into operation on the Sixth day of February Two Thousand and twenty-three for Zones N6, N7, S5, S6 and S7 and on the Fourteenth day of February Two Thousand and twenty-three for Zone N8.

- 1) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made under the 1984 Act or by or under any other enactment.
- 2) Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018, shall have effect subject to the variations, insertions, substitutions and additions thereto specified in Schedule 1 of this Order.
- 3) In this part of the Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the follow expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:

“the 2018 Order” means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018.

- 4) Designation of parking places and loading places and application of the 2018 Order thereto.
 - 1) Each area on a road identified in a map tile as a parking place or loading place and, where applicable, by way of either a map tile label or the map schedule legend, or both, as an area marked out and signed for the use therein of specified classes of vehicles following the conditions specified in the 2018 Order in relation to that type of parking place or loading place, is designated as a parking place or, as the case may be, a loading place.
 - 2) Unless otherwise so identified, a parking place or a loading place shall be bounded on one side of its length by the edge of the carriageway and be an area marked either by a traffic sign or by another method of indicating the extent of a parking place or loading place as specified in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
 - 3) The provisions of the 2018 Order (other than Articles 3-1 and 7-1) shall apply to an area designated as a parking place by this Order as if in those provisions any reference to:
 - a) a parking place included a reference to an area designated as a parking place by this Order, and
 - b) a loading place included a reference to an area designated as a loading place by this Order.

- 4) Loading prohibition and/or waiting restrictions applicable in prohibited or restricted roads.


Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the 2018 Order shall have effect as though any loading prohibition and/or waiting restriction identified in a map tile and, where applicable, by way of either a map tile label or the map schedule legend, or both, and marked out and signed as a loading prohibition and/or waiting restriction shall be construed as though it were a prohibited road and/or a restricted road referred to in the 2018 Order.

- 5) Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018, shall have the effect as if, in Schedule 2 to that Order: -

- 1) the version number listed for the following map tiles will increase by one whole number:

(ii) after the words “Grant of trades’ permits for the use of” there was inserted the word “resident”.

In Part 1 Citation and Interpretation

In Article 1-2 (a):

- (a) In item “Controlled Parking Zone”, for the words “comprises the roads which are so classified and specified in Sections 1 to 12 of Schedule 3 to this Order;” there were substituted the words “comprises the roads which are so classified and specified in Sections 1 to 12 and 23 to 42 of Schedule 3 to this Order;”.
- (b) After all the words in item “essential business use” there were inserted the words:
“garage services permit” means a permit granted by the Council to a qualifying garage services business under the terms of Article 5-29 of this Order;
“garage services permit holder” means a qualifying garage services business to which a permit or permits have been granted by the Council under the terms of Article 5-29 of this Order;
“garage services permit user” means a qualifying garage services business to which a permit or permits have been granted by the Council under the terms of Article 5-29 of this Order;”.
- (c) After all the words in item “medical practitioner” there were inserted the words:

"mews parking place" means any road, or as the case may be part of a road shown on a map tile and in a map schedule legend, where said road, or part of road, has a reference prefix "M";

- (d) In item "mews resident" for the word "numbered" where they occur three times, there was substituted the word "mews" respectively.
- (e) In item "mews retailer" for the word "numbered" where they occur two times, there was substituted the word "mews" respectively.
- (f) All the words in item "numbered parking place" were deleted.

(g) After all of the words in item "permit holder" there were inserted the words:
"permit parking area" means any road, or as the case may be part of a road shown on a map tile and in a map schedule legend, where said road, or part of road, has a reference prefix "P";

"permit parking area resident" means a person who is solely or mainly resident at premises having an address within a permit parking area and, for the avoidance of doubt, includes:

- 1) a person who is solely or mainly resident at a premises:
 - a. which have a physical boundary with a permit parking area; or
 - b. detailed in Schedule 9 to this Order;
- 2) a medical practitioner with consulting rooms the postal address of which is within a permit parking area;

"permit parking area retailer" means a retailer whose premises have a postal address within a permit parking area and for the avoidance of doubt includes a retailer with an address having a physical boundary with a permit parking area or whose premises are described in Schedule 9 to this Order;

"permit parking area business" means a business whose premises have a postal address within a permit parking area and for the avoidance of doubt includes a retailer with an address having a physical boundary with a permit parking area or whose premises are described in Schedule 9 to this Order;"

"permit parking area garage services business" means a garage services business whose premises have a postal address within a permit parking area and for the avoidance of doubt includes a garage services business with an address having a physical boundary with a permit parking area;"

- (h) In item "Priority Parking Area" for the words "Sections 12 to 22" there were substituted the words "Sections 13 to 22 and Sections 43 to 47".
- (i) In item "qualifying business", after the words "Sections 3 to 11" there were inserted the words " and Sections 23 to 42 ".
- (j) After item "qualifying business vehicle" there were inserted the words:
"qualifying garage services business" means the operator of a business undertaking services relating to motor vehicle maintenance such as, but not limited to MOTs, mechanical repairs, electrical repairs, welding or bodywork repairs, valeting or car washing, where the address of the said business is located on a road that is described in Sections 23 to 37 of Schedule 3;"
- (k) In item "qualifying resident" in paragraph (4), after the word "mews" there were inserted the words "or permit parking area".

- (l) In item “qualifying resident” in paragraph (5), for all of the words there were substituted the words “a resident whose property has a physical boundary with a designated mews parking place or permit parking area”.
- (m) In item “qualifying resident” after all of the words in paragraph (5), there were inserted the words “and for the avoidance of doubt, excludes any person resident in any premises referred to in Schedule 4”
- (n) In item “qualifying retailer” for the words “Sections 2 to 11 inclusive” there were substituted the words “Sections 2 to 11 and Sections 23 to 42”.
- (o) In item “qualifying retailer’s vehicle” in paragraph (2) for the words “Sections 3 to 11 inclusive” there were substituted the words “Sections 3 to 11 and Sections 23 to 42”.
- (p) In item “zone” in paragraph (b) after the words “Sections 1 to 12” there were inserted the words “ and Sections 23 to 42”.

In Part 3 Designation and use of Parking Places, Loading Places and Taxi Stances

In Article 3-2

- (a) In item (b) for the words “Each permit parking place” there were substituted the words “Each resident permit parking place”.
- (b) In item (b) in paragraph (1) (ii) before the words “permit parking place” there was inserted the word “resident ”.
- (c) In item (b)(2)
 - (i) for the words “and 13 to 22” there were substituted the words “and Sections 23 to 42”.
 - (ii) for the words “a valid business permit;” there were substituted the words “a valid business permit, provided that use by such vehicles of mews parking places and permit parking areas is restricted in accordance with paragraphs (h) and (i) of this Article;”
- (d) In item (b)(3)
 - (i) for the words “13 to 22” there were substituted the words “Sections 13 to 47”.
 - (ii) for the words “a valid visitors’ permit;” there were substituted the words “a valid visitors’ permit, provided that use by such vehicles of mews parking places and permit parking areas is restricted in accordance with paragraphs (h) and (i) of this Article;”.
- (e) In item (b)(4)
 - (i) After the words “Sections 2 to 11” there were inserted the words “ and Sections 23 to 42”.
 - (ii) for the words “Article 6-1; provided that the use of numbered parking places so indicated by a traffic sign shall be restricted to such vehicles of:
 - (i) mews residents as display a valid residents’ permit granted in terms of this Order; or

- (ii) mews retailers as display a valid retailers' permit granted in terms of this Order on which there is recorded an indication of the numbered parking place for which the said permit is granted." there were substituted the words: "Article 6-1; provided that the use by such vehicles of mews parking places and permit parking areas is restricted in accordance with paragraphs (h) and (i) of this Article."
- (f) In item (b)(5) for the number "22" there was substituted the word "28".
- (g) In item(c)(3) after the words "Sections 1 to 11" there were inserted the words "and Sections 23 to 42".
- (h) In item (c)(4) after the words "Sections 2 to 11" there were inserted the words "and 23 to 42".
- (i) In item (c)(5) after the words "Sections 2 to 11" there were inserted the words "and 23 to 42".
- (j) In item (c)(6) after the words "Sections 3 to 11" there were inserted the words "and 23 to 42".
- (k) After all the words in item (c)(6) as amended there were inserted the words:
 - "(7) qualifying vehicles using a valid garage services permit and which comply, where applicable, with the requirements of Article 6-1, where the parking place is identified by way of the map schedule legend or a map tile label as being located within a zone described in Sections 23 to 47 of Schedule 3."
 - (g) Each garage services parking place depicted in a map tile may be used, during the permitted hours as stated in either the map schedule legend or in a map tile label relating to that parking place, of such vehicles as are qualifying vehicles and which display, in accordance with the requirements of Article 6-1, a valid garage services permit which bears the same garage service permit reference as the parking place in which the vehicle is left.
 - (h) Each mews parking place depicted in a map tile may be used, during the permitted hours as stated in either the map schedule legend relating to the zone or, as the case may be, sub-zone in which the mews parking place is located, or in a map tile label relating to that parking place, for such vehicles as are qualifying vehicles and which display, in accordance with the requirements of Article 6-1, a valid:
 - (1) residents parking permit issued in respect of that mews parking place;
 - (2) trades parking permit, provided that no vehicle shall wait by virtue of this article in any mews parking place on a road described in Sections 1 to 22 of Schedule 3
 - (3) business parking permit, provided that no vehicle shall wait by virtue of this article in any mews parking place:
 - (i) on a road described in Sections 1 or 2 of Schedule 3; and
 - (ii) other than the mews parking place for which the permit was issued.
 - (4) retailers parking permit, provided that no vehicle shall wait by virtue of this article in any mews parking place:
 - (i) on a road described in Section 1 of Schedule 3; and

- (ii) other than the mews parking place for which the permit was issued.
- (i) Each permit parking area depicted in a map tile may be used, during the permitted hours as stated in either the map schedule legend relating to the zone or, as the case may be, sub-zone in which the permit parking area is located, or in a map tile label relating to that parking place, for such vehicles as are qualifying vehicles and which display, in accordance with the requirements of Article 6-1, a valid:
 - (1) residents parking permit issued in respect of that permit parking area;
 - (2) trades parking permit, provided that no vehicle shall wait by virtue of this article in any permit parking area on a road described in Sections 1 to 22 of Schedule 3
 - (3) visitor parking permit, provided that no vehicle shall wait by virtue of this article in any permit parking area on a road described in Sections 1 to 22 of Schedule 3
 - (4) business parking permit, issued to a qualifying business the address of which is located within the permit parking area; provided that no vehicle shall wait by virtue of this article in any permit parking area:
 - (i) on a road described in Sections 1 to 22 of Schedule 3
 - (ii) other than the permit parking area for which the permit was issued.
 - (5) retailers parking permit, issued to a qualifying retailer the address of which is located within the permit parking area; provided that no vehicle shall wait by virtue of this article in any permit parking area:
 - (i) on a road described in Sections 1 to 22 of Schedule 3
 - (ii) other than the permit parking area for which the permit was issued.
 - (6) garage services parking permit, issued to a garage services business the address of which is located within the permit parking area; provided that no vehicle shall wait by virtue of this article in any permit parking area:
 - (i) on a road described in Sections 1 to 22 of Schedule 3
 - (ii) other than the permit parking area for which the permit was issued.

In Article 3-4 (12) after the words “in the case of a” there was inserted the word “ resident”.

In Part 4 Pay and Display Parking and Limited Waiting:

- (a) In Article 4-7 after all the words in paragraph (b) there were inserted the words: - “
 - (c) a vehicle which displays a valid garage services permit in accordance with the requirements of Article 6-1, in a shared use parking place depicted in a map tile and where said shared use parking place bears the reference relating to the garage services business to which the garage services permit was issued.”

In Part 5 Permits: Specific Provisions

In Section 1 – General for all of the words in the title there were substituted the words “Permits for the use of resident permit parking places, pay and display parking places shared-use parking places, RNLI parking places and garage services parking places In Article 5-1

- (a) In item (a) after the words “entitled to be left in any” where they occur first and for the words “numbered permit” there were inserted the words “ resident” and “ mews” respectively.
- (b) In item (b) after the words “entitled to be left in any” there was inserted the word “ resident”.
- (c) In item (c) after the words “entitled to be left in any”, “sub-zone for each” and “map tile label relating to that” there were inserted the word “ resident” three times respectively.
- (d) After all the words in item (f) there were inserted the words: -
 - “(g) Any qualifying vehicle that displays a valid garage services permit granted under the terms of this Part of the Order shall be entitled to be left in a garage services parking place, during the permitted hours for which the permit has been granted; provided that use of a garage services permit is limited to those garage services parking places which bear the same garage services permit reference shown on a map tile or in a map tile label relating to that place.”

In the sub heading “Charges for permits for use at permit parking places,” after the words “Charges for permits for use at” there was inserted the word “ resident”.

In Article 5-2

- (a) In item (a) (1) after the words “permitted hours in any” there was inserted the word “ resident”.
- (b) In item (a) (3) after the words “permitted hours in any” and for the words “13 to 22” there was inserted the word “ resident” and substituted the words “Sections 13 to 47”.
- (c) In item (a) (4) after the words “as applicable, in any” and “Sections 2 to 11” there were inserted the words “ resident” and “and Sections 23 to 42 ”.
- (d) In item (a) (5) after the words “as applicable, in any” and “Sections 2 to 11” there were inserted the words “ resident” and “and Sections 23 to 42 ” respectively.
- (e) In item (a) (6) after the words “pay and display parking place,” and for the number “22” there was inserted the word “ resident” and substituted the number “47” respectively.
- (f) In item (a) (7) for the number “22” there was substituted the number “47”.
- (g) After all the words in item (a) (11) there were inserted the words: -
 - “(12) a garage services permit granted in respect of a qualifying garage services business for the use, by a garage services permit user, of such a permit on a qualifying vehicle left during the permitted hours in a garage services parking place or a shared-use parking place as depicted on a map tile or on a map tile label, within a zone, on a road described in Sections 23 to 47 of Schedule 3.”.

In Section 2 – Residents’ Permits

In the sub heading “Applications for residents’ permits for the use of permit parking places.....” after the words “Applications for residents’ permits for the use of ” there was inserted the word “ resident”.

In the sub heading “Grant of residents’ permits for the use of permit parking places.....” after the words “Grant of residents’ permits for the use of ” there was inserted the word “ resident”.

In Article 5-4 after the words “permit relates, in a ” and for the words “numbered permit parking place,” and the number “22” there was inserted the word “ resident” and substituted the words “mews parking place or permit parking area,” and the number “47” respectively.

In Article 5-5 in paragraph (a)(3) for the words “numbered parking place” there were substituted the words “mews parking place or a permit parking area ”.

In Article 5-7 (a)

- i. for the words “13 to 22” there were substituted the words “Sections 13 to 47”;
- ii. after the words “visitors permits relating to” there was inserted the word “ resident”.

In Article 5-8

(a) In item (a) for all the words there were substituted the words: -

“(a) On receipt of a valid application, the Council shall grant to the applicant visitors' permits, subject to the provisions of paragraph (b) of this Article, for the leaving of a qualifying vehicle during the permitted hours in:

- (1) a resident permit parking place, within a zone, on a road described in Sections 1 to 11 and Sections 13 to 47 of Schedule 3; or
- (2) a shared-use parking place, within a zone, on a road described in Sections 1 to 11 and Sections 23 to 42 of Schedule 3; or
- (3) a permit parking area, within a zone, on a road described in Sections 23 to 47 of Schedule 3;

the zone or sub-zone for each resident permit parking place or shared-use parking place or permit parking area being specified in either the map schedule legend or a map tile label relating to that permit parking place or shared-use parking place or permit parking area.”.

(b) In item (b) (2) after the words “Sections 3 to 11” there were inserted the words “ and Sections 23 to 42”.

(c) In item (b) (3) after the words “Sections 13 to 22” there were inserted the words “ and Sections 43 to 47”.

In Section 4 – Retailers’ Permits

In the sub heading “Applications for retailers’ permits for the use of permit parking places.....” after the words “Applications for retailers’ permits for the use of ” there was inserted the word “ resident”.

In Article 5-10

- (a) In item (c) (3) after the words “Sections 13 to 22” there were inserted the words “and Sections 43 to 47”.
- (b) In item (d) (ii) after the words “Sections 3 to 11” there were inserted the words “and Sections 23 to 42”.

In the sub heading “Grant of retailers’ permits for the use of permit parking places.....” after the words “Grant of retailers’ permits for the use of ” there was inserted the word “ resident”.

In Article 5-11

- (a) In item (a)
 - (i) after the words “permit relates, in ” there was inserted the word “resident”.
 - (ii) for the words “numbered parking places” there were substituted the words “mews parking place referenced with a prefix “M””.
- (b) In item (b)
 - (i) After the words “permit relates, in ”there was inserted the word “resident”.
 - (ii) for the words “numbered parking place” there were substituted the words “mews parkin area referenced with a prefix “M” ”.
 - (iii) after the words “and are described” there were inserted the words “in the case of:
 - (1) A mews parking place, in Sections 2 to 11 and Sections 23 to 42 of Schedule 3;
 - (2) A permit parking area, in Sections 23 to 42 of Schedule 3.”

In Article 5-12 (a) (3) for the words “numbered parking place” there were substituted the words “mews parking place or a permit parking area”.

In Section 5 – Business Permits

In the sub heading “Applications for business permits for the use of permit parking places.....” after the words “Applications for business permits for the use of ” there was inserted the word “ resident”.

In Article 5-13 (c) (2) after the words “2 and 13 to 22” there were substituted the words “2, 13 to 22 and Sections 43 to 47”.

In the sub heading “Grant of business permits for the use of permit parking places.....” after the words “Grant of business permits for the use of ” there was inserted the word “ resident”.

In Article 5-14

- (i) after the words “which the permit relates, in” there was inserted the word “ resident”.
- (ii) for the words “numbered parking place” there were substituted the words “mews parking place referenced with a prefix “M” or a permit parking area referenced with a prefix “P””.

- (iii) after the words “and as are described” there were inserted the words “in the case of:
 - (1) A mews parking place, in Sections 3 to 11 and Sections 23 to 42 of Schedule 3;
 - (2) A permit parking area, in Sections 23 to 42 of Schedule 3.”

Section 3 to 11” there were inserted the words “ and Sections 23 to 42”.

In Article 5-15 (a) (3) for the words “numbered parking place” there were substituted the words “mews parking place or a permit parking area”.

In Section 6 – Trades’ Permits

In the sub heading “Applications for trades’ permits for the use of pay and display parking places,” after the words “Applications for trades’ permits for the use of pay and display parking place, ” there was inserted the word “ resident”.

In the sub heading “Grant of trades’ permits for the use of pay and display parking places,” after the words “Grant of trades’ permits for the use of pay and display parking places, ” there was inserted the word “ resident”.

In Article 5-17

- (i) for the words “permit parking places or, shared-use parking places” there were substituted the words “resident permit parking places, shared-use parking places or permit parking areas”.
- (ii) for the number “22” there was substituted the number “47”.

“

Section 10 – Garage Services Permits

Applications for garage services permits for the use of garage services parking places and shared use parking places
5-28

- (a) Except as provided in paragraph (c) of this Article a:
 - (1) qualifying garage services business the address of which is listed in Schedule 8, may apply to the Council for the grant of permits in respect of customer vehicles and for the associated garage services parking place so prefixed with a reference number beginning with a “G” with which the qualifying garage services business is associated, and any such application shall:
 - (i) be made on a form issued by, and obtainable from, the Council;
 - (ii) be made in the trading name of the garage services business for which the permit is intended;
 - (iii) include the information or particulars as specified on the aforementioned form;
 - (iv) be accompanied by means of payment of the appropriate charge for the said permit or permits as is specified in Schedule 6.
 - (2) qualifying garage services business the address of which is not listed in Schedule 8, may apply to the Council, in accordance with the requirements

detailed in para (a)(1) of this article, for the grant of permits in respect of customer vehicles for use in shared use parking places in the vicinity of their place of business, until such time as their address is added to the aforementioned Schedule 8.

- (b) The Council may at any time require a qualifying garage services business applying for garage services permits to produce to an officer of the Council:
 - (1) in respect of an application for a permit, such evidence as they may reasonably require to verify any particulars or information given to them: or
 - (2) in respect of any previously granted permit, such evidence as they may reasonably require to verify that the permit is valid or that the garage services business permit holder remains entitled to the said permit.
- (c) The Council shall not grant permits, under the terms of this Section where the trading address of the garage services business is referred to in:
 - (1) Schedule 4, List of roads and properties where the grant of permits is restricted, for the reasons as described in that Schedule; or
 - (2) Sections 1 to 22 of Schedule 3.

Grant of garage services permits for the use of garage services parking places
5-29

Except as provided for in this Part of the Order, on receipt of a valid application the Council shall grant to the qualifying garage services business no more than the maximum number of garage services permits specified in Schedule 8, or in the case of an application to which paragraph (a)(2) of Article 5-28 applies, no more than 8 permits, for the leaving, during the permitted hours, of the qualifying vehicles of garage service business users, in a garage services parking place or as the case may be, a shared use parking place or a permit parking area, in all cases referenced with a prefix “G” provided that the use of a garage services permit is limited to those garage services parking places and shared use parking places which bear the same garage services permit reference as said permit.

Form of garage services business permits
5-30

A garage service permit shall be in one of the following forms:

- (a) in writing and shall include the following particulars:-
 - (1) the garage services reference with a prefix “G”;
 - (2) the period during which, subject to the provisions of Article 6-3 of this Order, the permit shall remain valid;
 - (3) the specified zone and, where applicable, the mews parking place or a permit parking area reference in accordance with the provisions of Article 3-2, in respect of which the use of the permit is valid;
 - (4) an indication that the permit was granted by the Council;
 - (5) an indication that the appropriate charge, for the period during which the permit shall remain valid, has been paid to the Council.
- (b) in electronic format, with the:-
 - (1) permit details listed in paragraph (a) of this article; and
 - (2) registration mark of the qualifying vehicle of the garage services permit user, held centrally by, or on behalf of, the Council and accessible via a hand-held device;
- (c) in any other form as may be determined from time to time by the Council.

Additional validity of garage services business permits

5-31

In accordance with the provisions of Article 5-28(a)(2) a garage services permit business not listed in Schedule 8 to whom permits have been issued by virtue of said Article shall be entitled to use shared use parking places in the vicinity of their place of business, until such time as their address is added to Schedule 8, provided that any vehicle left in any parking place by virtue of this Article must comply with the requirements of Article 6-1.

Use of Garage Services permits

5-32

The use of a garage services permit;

- (a) is restricted to qualifying vehicles of customers of the qualifying garage services business to whom the permit has been issued and for the avoidance of doubt cannot be used by employees of the garage services business;
- (b) on any individual vehicle is restricted to a period no longer than 5 consecutive days on which the permit is valid for use.”.
