

ROADS (SCOTLAND) ACT 1984

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (LAURISTON PLACE, EDINBURGH)  
(REDETERMINATION OF MEANS OF EXERCISE OF PUBLIC RIGHT OF PASSAGE)  
ORDER 2023 - RSO/18/14

The City of Edinburgh Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 1(1) and 152 (2) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The City of Edinburgh Council (Lauriston Place, Edinburgh) (Redetermination of Means of Exercise of Public Right of Passage) Order 2023" and shall come into operation on the First day of June Two thousand Twenty-three.
2. The roads in the City of Edinburgh local government area specified in the Schedule to this Order, at present carriageway, shall become footway, the right of passage being exercisable by foot only.

## SCHEDULE

### ROAD OVER WHICH MEANS OF EXERCISE OF PUBLIC RIGHT OF PASSAGE IS TO BE REDETERMINED FROM CARRIAGEWAY TO FOOTWAY

#### **Lauriston Place**

##### South Side

1. All that part of the carriageway on the south side of Lauriston Place from a point 64 metres or thereby east of the intersection of the extended east kerblines of Nightingale Way and the extended south kerblines of Lauriston Place eastwards,
  - a) for a distance of 1.5 metres or thereby and which has a width that varies from 0 metres or thereby to 3 metres or thereby, then
  - b) for a distance of 3.5 metres or thereby and which has a width throughout of 3 metres or thereby and then
  - c) for a distance of 1.5 metres or thereby and which has a width that varies from 3 metres or thereby to 0 metres or thereby.(the eastern most area on the attached plan).
  
2. All that part of the carriageway on the south side of Lauriston Place from a point 81.5 metres or thereby east of the intersection of the extended east kerblines of Nightingale Way and the extended south kerblines of Lauriston Place eastwards,
  - a) for a distance of 1.5 metres or thereby and which has a width that varies from 0 metres or thereby to 3 metres or thereby, then
  - b) for a distance of 3.5 metres or thereby and which has a width throughout of 3 metres or thereby and then
  - c) for a distance of 1.5 metres or thereby and which has a width that varies from 3 metres or thereby to 0 metres or thereby.(the western most area on the attached plan).

All as the lengths of roads are shown in sawtooth hatching on the plan annexed and executed as relative to the Order.
