## THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (SPIER'S PLACE) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2023 – TEMP/23/110

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act"), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

- This Order may be cited as "The City of Edinburgh Council (Spier's Place) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2023". The Order shall have effect from the Twenty-second of May Two thousand and twenty-three up to and including the Fourteenth day of June Two thousand and twenty-three.
- In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them: "Article" means an Article of this Order; "emergency service vehicle" means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire or police purposes; "Parking Attendant" has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act; "vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984; and "the 2018 Order" means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018.
- 3. Save as provided in Article 4, to facilitate public realm works (as signed as affected by the works), no person shall:-
  - (a) drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on **Spier's Place**, at its junction with Henderson Street; and
  - (b) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle at any time on *both sides* of Spier's Place, between its junction with Henderson Street and its junction with Giles Street.
- 4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles in actual use with the undertaking of the works.
- 5. The 2018 Order will be suspended in so far as it is affected by the measures described in Article 3(b) of this Order.
- 6. The alternative route for through vehicular traffic with respect to the *closure* will be by way of Henderson Street, Yardheads, Cables Wynd, Parliament Street and Giles Street.
