THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (EDINBURGH INTERNATIONAL CHILDREN'S FESTIVAL) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2023 – TEMP/23/120

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 62 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act"), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

- This Order may be cited as "The City of Edinburgh Council (Edinburgh International Children's Festival) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2023". The Order shall have effect during the hours and on the dates specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them: "Article" means an Article of this Order;
 - "emergency service vehicle" means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire or police purposes;
 - "Parking Attendant" has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;
 - "road" has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the 1984 Act and, for the avoidance of doubt, for the purposes of this Order, includes part of a road;
 - "Schedule" means a Schedule to this Order;
 - "vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the 1984 Act; and
 - "the 2018 Order" means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018.
- 3. Save as provided in Article 4, to facilitate the safe access/egress of children at Festival venues (as signed as affected by the event), no person shall, except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle on the roads described in Schedule 1 hereto, during the hours and on the dates specified in the said Schedule.
- 4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall apply to emergency service vehicles.
- 5. The 2018 Order shall be suspended on the affected sections of roads described in Schedule 1, during the hours and on the dates specified in the said Schedule.

SCHEDULE 1 PROHIBITION OF WAITING, LOADING & UNLOADING

- (A) <u>from 08:00 hours to 17:00 hours DAILY from 29/05/2023 to 02/06/2023</u> on:
- (i) **Castle Terrace**, *south side*, from its junction with Cambridge Street, south-eastwards for a distance of 50 metres or thereby; and (ii) **Nicolson Street**, *west side*, from the projected south gable end of No. 101 Nicolson Street, southwards for a distance of 35 metres or thereby.
- (B) from 08:00 hours to 17:00 hours DAILY from 27/05/2023 to 05/06/2023 on:

Roxburgh Place, *east side*, from its junction with Drummond Street, south-eastwards for a distance of 30 metres or thereby; and

- (C) from 08:00 hours to 17:00 hours on 01/06/2023 and 02/06/2023 on:
- (i) **Hope Park Terrace**, *south side*, from a point 10 metres or thereby south-west of the extended western kerbline of South Clerk Street, south-westwards for a distance of 48 metres or thereby; and (ii) **King's Stables Road**, *north side*, from a point 7.5 metres or thereby west of the western edge of the wall adjacent Granny's Green Steps, westwards for a distance of 50 metres or thereby.
