THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (EDINBURGH MARATHON FESTIVAL) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2023 – TEMP/23/129

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act"), as amended, and of all other enabling powers being satisfied that traffic on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedules hereto should be prohibited or restricted to facilitate the holding of the Edinburgh Marathon Festival event and to enable members of the public to watch this event and being satisfied that it is not reasonably practicable for the event to be held otherwise than on a road and having had regard to the safety and convenience of alternative routes suitable for traffic which will be affected by this Order, with the consent of the Scottish Ministers under section 16B(6)(b) of the said Act, hereby make the following Order: -

- 1. This Order may be cited as "The City of Edinburgh Council (Edinburgh Marathon Festival) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2023". The Order shall have effect during the hours and on the dates specified in the Schedules to this Order.
- 2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them: "Article" means an Article of this Order;
 - "emergency service vehicle" means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire or police purposes;
 - "event buses" means a vehicle authorised by City of Edinburgh Council as being connected with the event;
 - "Parking Attendant" has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act;
 - "Schedule" means a Schedule to this Order;
 - "SFRS vehicles" means a vehicle being used by the Scottish Fire & Rescue Service;
 - "vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984; and "the 2018 Order" means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018.
- 3. Save as provided in Article 4, to facilitate the holding of the Edinburgh Marathon Festival (as signed as affected by the event), no person shall:-
 - (a) drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on the sections of roads specified in Schedule 1 hereto, where closures will apply to roads in their entirety unless otherwise stated:
 - (b) drive or cause or permit any motor vehicle to be driven on the sections of roads specified in Schedule 2 hereto;
 - (c) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle on the sections of roads specified in Schedule 3 hereto, where prohibitions will apply to both sides of the roads in their entirety unless otherwise stated; and
 - (d) drive or cause or permit any vehicle to be driven on the sections of roads specified in Schedule 4 hereto, otherwise than in the direction specified in the said Schedule.

4. Nothing in:

- (i) Article 3(b) shall apply to *event buses* and *SFRS vehicles* on the sections of **Buccleuch Place** and **Restalrig Road South** described in Schedule 2; and
- (ii) Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles.

- 5. The 2018 Order shall be suspended in so far as it is affected by the restrictions specified in Schedule 2 of this Order.
- 6. 'The City of Edinburgh Council (Holyrood Road Area) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2023' will be suspended in relation to the *prohibition of motor vehicles* and *waiting, loading & unloading prohibitions* on the affected sections of Canongate, Holyrood Gait, Holyrood Park Road and Horse Wynd specified in the Schedules to this Order, to facilitate event specific restrictions relating to the Edinburgh Marathon Festival event.
- 7. 'The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading and Parking Places) (Variation No 1) Order 2010' shall be suspended between *05:00 hours and 11:00 hours on 28/05/2023* in relation to the *one-way restriction* on West Crosscauseway, to facilitate two-way traffic.
- 8. 'The Edinburgh Corporation (Nicolson Square) (One-Way) Order 1962' shall be suspended between 17:00 hours on 27/05/2023 and 13:00 hours on 28/05/2023 in relation to the one-way restriction on Nicolson Square, to facilitate two-way traffic on its south leg.
- 9. 'The City of Edinburgh Council (High Street, Edinburgh) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) (Variation No 1) Order 2011' shall be suspended between 06:00 hours and 12:00 hours on 28/05/2023 in relation to the prohibition of motor vehicles on the section of High Street between Parliament Square and Cockburn Street, to facilitate traffic use on the section of road.
- 10. 'The City of Edinburgh Council (Ramsay Lane and Castlehill, Edinburgh) (Prohibition of Entry) Traffic Regulation Order 1999' shall be suspended between 06:00 hours and 12:00 hours on 28/05/2023 in relation to the prohibition of entry on Ramsay Lane, to facilitate traffic access/egress from Ramsay Lane to Castlehill.
- 11. 'The City of Edinburgh Council (Johnston Terrace, Edinburgh) (Bus Priority Lane and One-Way) Traffic Regulation Order 2001' shall be suspended between *06:00 hours and 12:00 hours on 28/05/2023* in relation to the *one-way restriction* on **Johnston Terrace**, to facilitate two-way traffic.
- 12. 'The Lothian Regional Council (Victoria Street, West Bow and Candlemaker Row, Edinburgh) Traffic Regulation Order 1995' shall be suspended between *06:00 hours and* 12:00 hours on 28/05/2023 in relation to the *one-way restrictions* on Victoria Street and Candlemaker Row, to facilitate two-way traffic.
- 13. 'The Edinburgh Corporation (Meadowbank Avenue and Assembly Street) (One-Way) Order 1965' shall be suspended between *06:00 hours and 12:30 hours on 28/05/2023* in relation to the *one-way restriction* on **Meadowbank Avenue**, to facilitate two-way traffic.

14. The alternative route for through vehicular traffic with respect to the *closures* will be by way of Melville Drive, Brougham Place, Brougham Street, Earl Grey Street, Lothian Road or South Bridge, North Bridge and Waterloo Place.

- (i) **Restalrig Road South**, *both sides*, between its junction with Restalrig Avenue and its junction with Portobello Road; (ii) **Restalrig Avenue**; (iii) **Craigentinny Avenue**; (iv) **Fillyside Road**; (v) **Seafield Road East**, *both sides*, from the extended south-eastern kerbline of Fillyside Road, south-eastwards to the extended northern kerbline of Seafield Road East (*service road*); (vi) **Portobello Road**, *south side*, between its junction with Willowbrae Road and its junction with Piershill Lane; (vii) **King's Place**; (viii) **Musselburgh Road**, *north side*, in its entirety; (ix) **Joppa Road**, *both sides*, between its junction with Joppa Park and its junction with Musselburgh Road; (x) **Seafield Terrace and Eastfield** (*B6415*), *both sides*, from the point it adjoins Musselburgh Road to the point it adjoins Edinburgh Road; (xi) **A199**, *both sides*, from the point it adjoins Eastfield Road to the point it adjoins Edinburgh Road; (xii) **Bristo Place**; (xiii) **George IV Bridge**; (xiv) **Bank Street**; (xv) **North Bank Street**; (xvi) **The Mound**; (xvii) **South Bridge**; (xviii) **Waverley Bridge**; (xix) **Market Street**; (xx) **Jeffrey Street**; and (xxi) **Meadowbank Terrace**;
- (H) from 18:30 hours on 27/05/2023 to 12:30 hours on 28/05/2023 on:
- (i) Potterrow; (ii) Chapel Street; (iii) Buccleuch Street; (iv) Buccleuch Place: (1) north side, in its entirety; and (2) south side, from the projected east property boundary of No. 21 Buccleuch Place, westwards for a distance of 40 metres or thereby (including central reservation parking); (v) Marshall Street; (vi) Nicolson Square, all sides in its entirety; (vii) George Square, all sides in its entirety; (viii) George Square Lane; (ix) Crichton Street; (x) Charles Street; (xi) West Crosscauseway; (xii) Meadow Lane; (xiii) Forrest Road; (xiv) Teviot Place; and (xv) Hope Park Crescent.

SCHEULDE 4 ONE-WAY ROADS

(A) from 06:00 hours to 10:30 hours on 27/05/2023 on:

Duddingston Road West, between its junction with North Cairntow and its junction with The Causeway, otherwise than in a *southbound* direction;

(B) <u>from 06:00 hours to 11:00 hours on 28/05/2023</u> on:

Hanover Street, between its junction with Rose Street and its junction with Princes Street, otherwise than in a *northbound* direction.
