THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (LAUDER ROAD AREA) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2023 – TEMP/23/89

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act"), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

- 1. This Order may be cited as "The City of Edinburgh Council (Lauder Road Area) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2023" and shall come into operation on the Seventh day of July Two thousand and twenty-three and shall remain in force up to and including the Thirty-first day of August Two thousand and twenty-three.
- 2. In this Order the following phrases have the meaning respectively assigned to them: "Article" means an Article of this Order;
 - "emergency service vehicle" means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire or police purposes;
 - "Parking Attendant" has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act; "vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984; and "the 2018 Order" means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018.
- 3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, to facilitate carriageway resurfacing and drainage channel repair works (as signed as affected by the works), no person shall:-
 - (a) drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on (i) **Dick Place**: (1) at its east junction with Lauder Road; and (2) at its west junction with Lauder Road: (ii) **Dalrymple Crescent**, at its junction with Lauder Road; and (iii) **Lauder Loan**, at its junction with Lauder Road; and
 - (b) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle on *both sides* of (i) Lauder Road, between its junction with Grange Road and its junction with Grange Loan; (ii) Dick Place, from its east and west junctions with Lauder Road, eastwards and westwards for a distance of 10 metres or thereby respectively; (iii) Dalrymple Crescent, from its junction with Lauder Road, north-eastwards for a distance of 50 metres or thereby; (iv) Lauder Loan, from its junction with Lauder Road, south-westwards for a distance of 10 metres or thereby; and (v) Grange Loan, from the centre line of its junction with South Lauder Road, eastwards and westwards for a distance of 30 metres or thereby respectively.
- 4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles in actual use with the undertaking of the works.
- 5. The 2018 Order is hereby suspended in so far as it is affected by the measures described in Article 3(b) of this Order.
- 6. The alternative routes for through vehicular traffic will be by way of: (i) **Dick Place**: (1) Cumin Place, Grange Road and Lauder Road; and (2) Mansionhouse Road, Grange Road and Lauder Road; and (ii) **Dalrymple Crescent** Findhorn Place, Grange Loan and Lauder Road.

7. The following road has no available diversion, where access will be maintained: (iii) **Lauder Loan**.
