

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (SCOTLAND) ACT 1997

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (60 MORRISON STREET, EDINBURGH)
(STOPPING UP) ORDER 202_ – PO/23/06

The City of Edinburgh Council proposes to make an Order under the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997, to stop up the lengths of road described in the Schedule hereto, in order to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted under said Act. A copy of the Order, public notice, accompanying plan showing the roads to be stopped up, together with a statement of reasons and our privacy notice can be viewed free of charge, between 09:30 to 15:30, Mon-Fri, from 14/07/23 to 11/08/23 at Waverley Court reception or online at

www.edinburgh.gov.uk/trafficorders or www.tellmescotland.gov.uk. Any person may, within 28 days from 14/07/23 make representations or object to the making of the Order by notice, in writing, or e-mail to TRO.Consultations@edinburgh.gov.uk quoting reference **PO/23/06** to Traffic Orders, Waverley Court, 4 East Market Street, Edinburgh EH8 8BG. Representations and objections should state the name and address of the objector, the matters to which they relate and the grounds on which they are made.

After the 28 day period the Order will be confirmed as an unopposed Order by the Council or submitted to the Scottish Ministers for consideration as an opposed Order.
SCHEDULE LENGTHS OF ROAD TO BE STOPPED UP: Morrison St all that part of the road on the north side of Morrison Street from a point 4.863 metres or thereby west of the intersection of the extended west kerbline of Semple Street and the north kerbline of Morrison Street, westwards; a) for a distance of 6.993 metres or thereby and which has a width that varies from 0 metres or thereby to 2.84 metres or thereby, and then b) for a distance of 9.309 metres or thereby and which has a width that varies from 2.84 metres or thereby to 1.258 metres or thereby.
