## THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (TEMPLE PARK CRESCENT & POLWARTH PLACE, EDINBURGH) (STOPPING UP) ORDER 202\_ - PO/23/11

The City of Edinburgh Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 207 of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997, ("the 1997 Act") and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and being satisfied that it has become necessary to authorise the Stopping Up of the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted under Part III of the 1997 Act, and having complied with the provisions of Section 209 of and Schedule 16 to the 1997 Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be citied as "The City of Edinburgh Council (Temple Park Crescent & Polwarth Place, Edinburgh) (Stopping Up) Order 202\_" and shall come into operation 28 days after the date on which it is confirmed by The City of Edinburgh Council, or, if appropriate, by the Scottish Government.
- 2. The stopping up of the lengths of road in the City of Edinburgh local government area specified in the Schedule to this Order is hereby ordered.
- 3. Where there is immediately before the date on which the said length of road is stopped up under this Order, any apparatus belonging to any statutory undertakers under, in, on, over, along or across the length of road for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking the said statutory undertakers shall after commencement of this Order continue to have all rights in respect of the said apparatus as they had immediately before that date.

## SCHEDULE LENGTHS OF ROAD TO BE STOPPED UP

TEMPLE PARK CRESCENT (North-West Side)	All that part of the road on the north-west side of Temple Park Crescent from the south-west building line of 90 to 94 Temple Park Crescent, south-westwards for a distance of 39.5 metres or thereby and which has a width thoughout of 2.95 metres or thereby. (marked area A on the attached plan)
POLWARTH PLACE (South-West Side)	All that part of the road on the south-west side of Polwarth Place from the extended north-west building line of 15 to 19 Polwarth Place, north-westwards for a distance of 2.25 metres or thereby and which has a width throughout of 2.75 metres or thereby. (marked area B on the attached plan)

All as the said lengths of road are shown hatched on the plan and executed as relative to this Order.
