The Council proposes to make an order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended to: **1.** introduce a one-way northbound (except cycles) on Magdala Cres at its junction with West Coates/Haymarket Ter; **2.** remove the banned right turn from Haymarket Station Layby into Clifton Ter/Haymarket; **3.** introduce a bus lane Mon-Fri 7.30-9.30am & 4.00-6.30pm on the offside lane of St Andrew Sq (west limb); and **4.** remove the bus lane on the nearside lane of St Andrew Sq (west limb).
