THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (FLY MUSIC FESTIVAL) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2023 – TEMP/23/199

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -


1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (Fly Music Festival) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2023”. The Order shall have effect during the hours and on the dates specified in Article 3 of this Order.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meaning respectively assigned to them:
  - “Article” means an Article of this Order;
  - “emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire and rescue or police purposes;
  - “event vehicle” means any vehicle authorised by City of Edinburgh Council as being connected with the event;
  - “motor vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the 1984 Act;
  - “Parking Attendant” has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act;
  - “Schedule” means a Schedule to this Order;
  - “the 2018 Order” means ‘The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018’; and
  - “vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, to facilitate the holding of Fly Music Festival (as signed as affected by the event), no person shall ***between 07:00 hours on 08/09/2023 and 06:00 hours on 10/09/2023; and between 18:00 hours on 10/09/2023 and 23:59 hours on 21/09/2023:-***
  - (a) cause or permit any motor vehicle to enter, proceed or wait in or on **King’s Stables Road**, from the extended north-western kerbline of the vehicular access to the NCP car park, north-westwards to its junction with Lothian Road;
  - (b) walk or cause or permit any person to walk on the footway on the ***north-east side*** of **King’s Stables Road**, from a point opposite the extended north-western kerbline of the vehicular access to the NCP car park, north-westwards for a distance of 200 metres or thereby; and
  - (c) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle at any time on ***both sides*** of **King’s Stables Road**, from the extended north-western kerbline of the vehicular access to the NCP car park, north-westwards to its junction with Lothian Road.
4. Nothing in:
  - (i) Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles; and
  - (ii) Articles 3(a) shall apply to *event vehicles* on the sections of **King’s Stables Road** described in the said Article.
5. The 2018 Order is hereby suspended in so far as it is affected by the measures described in Article 3(c) of this Order.

6. The alternative route for through vehicular traffic with respect to the *prohibition of motor vehicles* will be by way of King's Stables Road, West Port, Lady Lawson Street, Spittal Street and Castle Terrace.
