THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (SIGHTHILL AVENUE AND SIGHTHILL DRIVE, EDINBURGH) (REDETERMINATION OF MEANS OF EXERCISE OF PUBLIC RIGHT OF PASSAGE) ORDER 2023 - RSO/21/06

The City of Edinburgh Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 1(1) and 152 (2) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Order: -

- 1. This Order may be cited as "The City of Edinburgh Council (Sighthill Avenue and Sighthill Drive, Edinburgh) (Redetermination of Means of Exercise of Public Right of Passage) Order 2023" and shall come into operation on the Eleventh day of September Two thousand and twenty-three.
- 2. The roads in the City of Edinburgh local government area specified in the Schedule to this Order, at present carriageway, shall become footway, the right of passage being exercisable by foot only.

SCHEDULE

ROAD OVER WHICH MEANS OF EXERCISE OF PUBLIC RIGHT OF PASSAGE IS TO BE REDETERMINED FROM CARRIAGEWAY TO FOOTWAY

Sighthill Avenue

(South-west side)

All that part of the carriageway on the south-west side of Sighthill Avenue from a point 16.7 metres or thereby north-westwards from the extended north kerbline of Sighthill Drive, south-westwards and then westwards to a point 15.5 metres or thereby west of the extended south-west kerbline of Sighthill Avenue and which has a width that varies from 0 metres or thereby to 4.9 metres or thereby.

Sighthill Drive

(North side)

See Sighthill Avenue.

All as the lengths of roads are shown in sawtooth hatching on the plan annexed and executed as relative to the Order.
