THE LOTHIAN REGIONAL COUNCIL (OLD LISTON ROAD AREA, NEWBRIDGE)
(WIDTH RESTRICTION AND PROHIBITION OF VEHICLES) TRAFFIC REGULATION
ORDER 1995 - TO/1357

The Lothian Regional Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Sections 1(1) and 2(1) to (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984, (which Act as so amended is hereinafter referred to as "the 1984 Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The Lothian Regional Council (Old Liston Road Area, Newbridge) (Width Restriction and Prohibition of Vehicles) Traffic Regulation Order 1995" and shall come into operation on the First day of June Nineteen hundred and Ninety-five.
2. In this Order the following words and phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:-
 - "Article" means an article of this Order;
 - "Chief Constable" means the Chief Constable for the Lothian and Borders Police area;
 - "public service vehicle" has the meaning assigned to that phrase by Section 1 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981;
 - "Schedule" means a Schedule to this Order.
3. The restriction imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made under the 1984 Act or by or under any other enactment.
4. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle the width of which, inclusive of any load on the vehicle, exceeds two metres on the length of road described in Schedule 1.
5. Save as provided in Article 6 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permisison of a police constable in uniform or a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to enter, proceed or wait in or on any part of the length or area of road described in Schedule 2.

6. The prohibition imposed by Article 5 shall not apply to:-

- (a) a vehicle while being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
- (b) a vehicle while being used in connection with any building operation, demolition or excavation in or adjacent to the length of road, the cleansing or lighting of the length of road, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the length of road or street furniture therein or thereon, the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to the length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line, or the placing, maintenance or removal of any traffic sign; or
- (c) a public service vehicle.

Old Liston Road:

From a point 38 metres or thereby south of the projected southern kerbline of Parkside for a distance of 6 metres or thereby southwards.

Schedule 2

The link road between the western kerbline of Old Liston Road and the access road to Newbridge Industrial Estate, a distance of 70 metres of thereby. ✓
