THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (EDINBURGH'S HOGMANAY) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2023 – TEMP/23/258

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act"), as amended, and of all other enabling powers being satisfied that traffic on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedules hereto should be prohibited or restricted to facilitate public safety during the Edinburgh's Hogmanay event, and to enable members of the public to watch this event and being satisfied that it is not reasonably practicable for the event to be held otherwise than on a road and having had regard to the safety and convenience of alternative routes suitable for traffic which will be affected by this Order, with the consent of the Scottish Ministers under sections 16B(1)(b) and 16B(6)(b) of the said Act, hereby make the following Order: -

- 1. This Order may be cited as "The City of Edinburgh Council (Edinburgh's Hogmanay) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2023". The order shall have effect during the hours and on the dates specified in the Schedules to this Order.
- 2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them: "Article" means an Article of this Order;
  - "authorised person" means a person or persons engaged in works directly related to the provision of events related to Edinburgh's Hogmanay, where said person is materially required to have access to a restricted area;
  - "emergency service vehicle" means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire and rescue or police purposes;
  - "motor vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the 1984 Act;
  - "Parking Attendant" has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act;
  - "Schedule" means a Schedule to this Order;
  - "the 2018 Order" means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018; and
  - "vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
- 3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, to facilitate public safety during the Edinburgh's Hogmanay event (as signed as affected by the event), no person shall:-
  - (a) drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on the sections of roads specified in Schedule 1 hereto, where closures will apply to roads in their entirety unless otherwise stated:
  - (b) drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle on the sections of roads specified in column 1 of Schedule 2, otherwise than in the direction specified in column 2 of Schedule 2 hereto, where restrictions will apply to roads in their entirety unless otherwise stated;
  - (c) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle on the sections of roads described in Schedule 3 hereto, where restrictions will apply to both sides of the roads in their entirety unless otherwise stated; and
  - (d) on foot, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, enter or proceed along or use in any other manner whatsoever any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 4 hereto, where prohibitions will apply to the footway in their entirety unless otherwise stated.
- 4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles.

- 5. Nothing in Article 3(d) shall apply to:
  - (a) an authorised person carrying out work directly in relation of the Edinburgh's Hogmanay; or
  - (b) is, or is acting on the authority of, a police constable in uniform.
- 6. The 2018 Order will be suspended in so far as it is affected by the restrictions specified in Article 3(c) of this Order.
- 7. 'The City of Edinburgh Council (Greenways) Order 1997', as amended, will be suspended between 17:00hrs on 31/12/2023 and 10:00hrs on 01/01/2024 in so far as the no waiting at any time and loading bays on **Lothian Road** are affected by the restrictions imposed in this Order.
- 8. Whilst this Order remains in force, 'The City of Edinburgh Council (Ramsay Lane and Castlehill, Edinburgh) (Prohibition of Entry) Traffic Regulation Order 1999' will be suspended *between 17:00 hours on 31/12/2023 and 06:00 hours on 01/01/2024* in relation to the *prohibition of entry* on **Ramsay Lane**, to allow access and egress from Ramsay Lane to Castlehill.
- 9. Whilst this Order remains in force, 'The City of Edinburgh Council (Johnston Terrace, Edinburgh) (Bus Priority Lane and One-Way) (Traffic Regulation) Order 2001' will be suspended *between 17:00 hours on 31/12/2023 and 06:00 hours on 01/01/2024* in relation to the *buses, taxis & cycles only lane* on **Johnston Terrace**, to allow general travel from Castle Terrace to Lawnmarket.
- 10. Whilst this Order remains in force, 'The Edinburgh Corporation (One-Way, Various Streets) (Traffic Regulation) Order 1951' and 'City of Edinburgh Council (Edinburgh Tram) (Prohibition of Entry, Motor Vehicles and Turning, One-Way Roads, Bus/Tram Priority Lanes and Weight Limit) Traffic Regulation Order 2010' will be suspended *between 19:00 hours on 31/12/2023 and 03:00 hours on 01/01/2024* in relation to the *one-way* on **Rutland Square** (at Canning Street) and **Rutland Street** (at Rutland Square), to permit access.
- 11. Whilst this order remains in force, 'The City of Edinburgh Council (LEZ Implementation Works) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2023' will be suspended between 14:00 hours on 31/12/2023 and 03:00 hours on 01/01/2024 in relation to the waiting, loading and unloading restrictions on Canongate, to facilitate the event-specific restrictions.
- 12. Whilst this Order remains in force, 'The City of Edinburgh Council (Edinburgh's Christmas) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2023' will be suspended as follows:
  - a. between 14:00 hours on 30/12/2023 and 06:00 hours on 01/01/2024 on **Market Street**:
  - b. between 18:00 hours on 30/12/2023 and 10:00 hours on 01/01/2024 on **Waverley Bridge**;
  - c. between 17:00 hours on 31/12/2023 and 06:00 hours on 01/01/2024 on Castle Street:
  - d. between 16:00 hours on 31/12/2023 and 10:00 hours on 01/01/2024 on North Castle Street; and
  - e. between 19:00 hours and 22:30 hours on 31/12/2023 on **Mound Precinct** in so far as the affected sections of roads are affected by the restrictions imposed in Article 3 of this Order.

The alternative route for through vehicular traffic will be by way of North Charlotte Street, Charlotte Square, Hope Street, Queensferry Street, Melville Street, Manor Place, Atholl Place, Torphichen Place, Morrison Link, West Approach Road, Lothian Road, Earl Grey Street, Lauriston Place, Forrest Road, Chambers Street, South Bridge, North Bridge, Leith Street, York Place and Queen Street.
