- 2. If you are unable, for any reason, to display the Notice for this 21-day period, a declaration to this effect must be made on the Certificate of Compliance.
- 3. Certificate of Compliance After 21 days has expired, complete this certificate, and return it to licensing@edinburgh.gov.uk . On no account should this be submitted with the application form.
