THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (CCWEL MELVILLE STREET AREA) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2024 – TEMP/24/42

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -


1. This Order may be cited as "The City of Edinburgh Council (CCWEL Melville Street Area) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2024". The order shall have effect on the Eighth day of April Two thousand and twenty-four and shall remain in force up to and including the Twentieth day of December Two thousand and twenty-four.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:
  - “Article” means an Article of this Order;
  - “emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire and rescue or police purposes;
  - “motor vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the 1984 Act;
  - “Parking Attendant” has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act;
  - “the 2018 Order” means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018; and
  - “vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
3. Save as provided in Article 4, to facilitate carriageway and footway reconstruction works (as signed as affected by the works), no person shall:-
  - (a) drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on: (i) **Walker Street** (*north section*), from the point it meets Melville Crescent (*north section*), north-westwards to the projected south property boundary of No. 23 Walker Street; (ii) **Melville Crescent** (*north section*), from both of its junctions with Melville Street, north-westwards to the point it meets Walker Street (*north section*); and (iii) **Melville Street** (*cycleways only*), in its entirety;
  - (b) drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle on: (i) **Walker Street** (*south section*), from its junction with William Street, north-westwards to the point it meets Melville Crescent (*south section*); and (ii) **Melville Crescent** (*south section*), from the point it meets Walker Street (*south section*), north-westwards to both of its junctions with Melville Street, otherwise than in a **northbound** direction; and
  - (c) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle at any time on **both sides** of: (i) **Walker Street**, from the projected south property boundary of No. 23 Walker Street, south-eastwards to its junction with William Street; (ii) **Melville Crescent**, in its entirety; and (iii) **Melville Street**, from the projected east property boundary of No. 40 Melville Street, south-westwards to the projected west property boundary of No. 56 Melville Street.
4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles in actual use with the undertaking of the works.
5. The 2018 Order will be suspended in so far as it is affected by the restrictions specified in Article 3(c) of this Order.

6. The alternative route for through vehicular traffic with respect to the *closures* of **Melville Crescent** (*north section*) and **Walker Street** (*north section*) will be by way of Melville Street, Queensferry Street and Drumsheugh Gardens.
7. The alternative route for through vehicular traffic with respect to the *one-way restriction* will be by way of: (1) *eastbound* – Melville Street, Queensferry Street, Alva Street and William Street; and (2) *westbound*: (i) Melville Street, Manor Place, Shandwick Place and Coates Crescent; or (ii) Melville Street, Manor Place, Shandwick Place, Coates Crescent, Shandwick Place, Stafford Street and William Street.
