THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (A1 AREA) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2024 – TEMP/24/56

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (A1 area) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2024”. The order shall have effect on the Twenty-fifth day of April Two thousand and twenty-four and shall remain in force up to and including the Twenty-eighth day of June Two thousand and twenty-four.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:
 - “Article” means an Article of this Order;
 - “emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire and rescue or police purposes;
 - “motor vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the 1984 Act;
 - “Parking Attendant” has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act;
 - “public service vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 1 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981, and, for the purposes of this Order, applies where the said vehicle or vehicles are being operated as a Local Service, as defined in the said Act;
 - “Schedule” means a Schedule to this Order;
 - “taxi” has the same meaning as in Section 23 of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982; and
 - “vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
3. Save as provided in Article 4, to facilitate carriageway resurfacing and safety barrier upgrade works (as signed as affected by the works), no person shall **between 19:30 hours and 06:30 hours DAILY Monday–Friday**:
 - (a) drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on: (i) **The Jewel**, between its junction with Redman Drive and its junction with The Jewel roundabout; and (ii) **Milton Link**, at its junction with The Jewel roundabout; and
 - (b) drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle on: (i) **A1**, from The Jewel Roundabout to a point 25 metres south-east from the Newcraighall Rail Bridge, otherwise than in a **northbound** direction; and (ii) **A1**, at its junction with The Jewel roundabout, otherwise than in a **southbound** direction.
4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles in actual use with the undertaking of the works.
5. No person shall, drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on the road specified in column 1 so as to drive at a speed in excess of that specified in column 2, which shall reduce the speed limit from that specified in column 3 in the Schedule to this Order.
6. “The Lothian Regional Council (Part of the Jewel, Edinburgh) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Traffic Regulation Order 1988” will be suspended in relation to the *prohibition of motor vehicles (except public service vehicles and taxis)* on **The Jewel**, to allow for traffic to be diverted as described in Article 10.

7. “The City of Edinburgh Council (A1 Interchange at Fort Kinnaird, Edinburgh) (Bus Priority Lane) Traffic Regulation Order 2008” will be suspended in relation to the *bus lane* at the **A1 southbound off-slip Fort Kinnaird** (*south-east side*), to allow for traffic to be diverted as described in Article 9(ii).
8. “The City of Edinburgh Council (A1, The Jewel to Newcraighall, Edinburgh) (50 mph Speed Limit) Order 2006” will be suspended in relation to the *50-mph speed limit* on the **A1**, to allow for the temporary speed limit of 30 mph described in Article 5.
9. The alternative routes for through vehicular traffic with respect to the *one-way restrictions* will be by way of: (i) **A1 south-eastbound** – A199 through Musselburgh until it rejoins the A1; or Milton Road, A6106, The Wisp, A7 and Sheriffhall roundabout; and (ii) **A1 north-westbound** – Newcraighall Road, Duddingston Park South, Duddingston Crescent and Sir Harry Lauder Road.
10. The alternative route for through vehicular traffic with respect to the *closures* will be by way of Milton Link, Duddingston Crescent, Duddingston Park South and The Jewel.
