THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (BAIRD ROAD & HARVEST ROAD,  
NEWBRIDGE/RATHO AREA) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC  
REGULATION) ORDER 2024 – TEMP/24/47

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (Baird Road & Harvest Road, Newbridge/Ratho Area) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2024”. The order shall have effect on the Twenty-ninth day of April Two thousand and twenty-four and shall remain in force up to and including the Fourteenth day of June Two thousand and twenty-four.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:  
“Article” means an Article of this Order;  
“emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire and rescue or police purposes;  
“Parking Attendant” has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act; and  
“vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
3. Save as provided in Article 4, to facilitate carriageway resurfacing works (as signed as affected by the works), no person shall:-
  - (a) drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle **between 7am and 7pm Monday-Friday** on: (i) **Baird Road**, from the projected north gable end of No. 27 Baird Road, generally northwards to a point 50 metres or thereby north of the projected north property boundary of No. 70 Baird Road; and (ii) **Harvest Road**, from the extended northern kerbline of the vehicular access to Norton House Hotel & Spa, generally southwards to a point 170 metres or thereby south-east of the extended southern kerbline of the vehicular access to Hillwood Farm, provided that no more than one of the measures described in this section shall be enacted at any time; and
  - (b) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle at any time on **both sides** of (i) **Baird Road**, in its entirety; and (ii) **Harvest Road**, in its entirety.
4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles in actual use with the undertaking of the works.
5. The alternative route for through vehicular traffic with respect to the *closures* will be by way of Main Street (Ratho), Wilkieston Road and Cliftonhall Road (B7030).
