THE LOTHIAN REGIONAL COUNCIL (OXGANGS FARM DRIVE, EDINBURGH)
(PROHIBITION OF VEHICLES) TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 1993 - TO 1497

The Lothian Regional Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1) and 2(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 (which Act as so amended is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

- This Order may be cited as "The Lothian Regional Council (Oxgangs Farm Drive, Edinburgh) (Prohibition of Vehicles) Traffic Regulation Order 1993" and shall come into operation on the First day of September Nineteen hundred and Ninety three.
- 2. In this Order:-

"Article" means an article of this Order;

"Chief Constable" means the Chief Constable for the Lothian and Borders police area;

"public service vehicle" has the meaning assigned to it in Section 1 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981;

"Schedule" means the Schedule to this Order;

"traffic sign" means a sign of any size, colour and type prescribed or authorised under or having effect as though prescribed or authorised under Section 64 of the Act of 1984 and includes any line or mark on a road for conveying warnings, information, requirements, restrictions or prohibitions.

- 3. The restriction imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.
- 4. Save as provided in Article 5 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to enter, proceed or wait in or on any part of the length or areas of road described in the Schedule to this Order (hereinafter referred to as "the prohibited area").
- 5. The prohibition imposed by Article 4 shall not apply to:-
 - (a) a vehicle while being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (b) a vehicle while being used in connection with any building operation, demolition or excavation in or adjacent to the length of road, the cleansing or lighting of the length of road, the maintenance, improvement/

improvement or reconstruction of the length of road or street furniture therein or thereon, the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to the length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line, or the placing, maintenance or removal of any traffic sign;

- (c) a public service vehicle proceeding in a southerly direction on the prohibited area for the purpose of making a left turn into Redford Road;
- (d) a pedal cycle while either (i) making a left turn from Redford Road into the prohibited area or (ii) making a left turn from the prohibited area into Redford Road.
