THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (WOODHALL BANK AREA) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2024 – TEMP/24/61

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (Woodhall Bank Area) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2024”. The order shall have effect on the Twenty-seventh day of May Two thousand and twenty-four and shall remain in force up to and including the Fourth day of October Two thousand and twenty-four.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:
“Article” means an Article of this Order;
“emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire and rescue or police purposes;
“Parking Attendant” has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act; and
“vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
3. Save as provided in Article 4, to facilitate footway reconstruction works (as signed as affected by the works), no person shall:-
 - (a) drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle **between 8am and 5pm Monday-Friday on Woodhall Bank**: (1) from its junction with Woodhall Road (*west junction*), southwards to the projected south property boundary of No. 26 Woodhall Bank; (2) from the projected south property boundary of No. 26 Woodhall Bank, generally eastwards to the projected south property boundary of No. 16 Woodhall Bank; and (3) from the projected south property boundary of No. 16 Woodhall Bank, northwards to its junction with Woodhall Road (*east junction*), provided that no more than one of the measures described in this section shall be enacted at any time; and
 - (b) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle at any time on **both sides** of (i) **Woodhall Road**, from a point 20 metres or thereby east of its junction with Woodhall Bank (*east junction*), westwards to a point 20 metres or thereby west of its junction with Woodhall Bank (*west junction*); and (ii) **Woodhall Bank**, in its entirety.
4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles in actual use with the undertaking of the works.
5. The alternative route for through vehicular traffic with respect to the *closures* will be by way of Woodhall Road and Woodhall Bank.
