### THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (PRIDE EDINBURGH) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2024 – TEMP/24/92

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as amended, and of all other enabling powers being satisfied that traffic on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedules hereto should be prohibited or restricted to facilitate the holding of the Pride Edinburgh event, and to enable members of the public to watch this event and being satisfied that it is not reasonably practicable for the event to be held otherwise than on a road and having had regard to the safety and convenience of alternative routes suitable for traffic which will be affected by this Order, with the consent of the Scottish Ministers under section 16B(6)(b) of the said Act, hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (Pride Edinburgh) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2024”. The order shall have effect on the Twenty-second day of June Two thousand and twenty-four, during the hours specified in the Schedules to this Order.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:
  - “Article” means an Article of this Order;
  - “emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire or police purposes;
  - “event vehicle” means any vehicle authorised by City of Edinburgh Council as being connected with the event;
  - “motor vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the 1984 Act;
  - “Parking Attendant” has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act;
  - “Schedule” means a Schedule to this Order;
  - “the 2018 Order” means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018; and
  - “vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
3. Save as provided in Article 4, to facilitate the holding of the Pride Edinburgh event (as signed as affected by the event), no person shall:-
  - (a) drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on the sections of roads specified in Schedule 1 hereto, where closures will apply to roads in their entirety unless otherwise stated;
  - (b) drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle on the section of road specified in column 1 of Schedule 2, otherwise than in the direction specified in column 2 of Schedule 2 hereto; and
  - (c) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle on the sections of roads specified in Schedule 3 hereto, where prohibitions will apply to both sides of the roads in their entirety unless otherwise stated.
4. Nothing in:
  - (i) Article 3(c) shall apply to *event vehicles* on the section of **Holyrood Road** described in Schedule 3; and
  - (ii) Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles.
5. The 2018 Order will be suspended in so far as it is affected by the restrictions specified in Article 3(c) of this Order.

6. The alternative route for through vehicular traffic with respect to the **closures** will be by way of North Bridge, South Bridge, Clerk Street, Hope Park Crescent/Melville Drive, Lothian Road, Semple Street, Morrison Street, Grassmarket and Cowgate.

SCHEDULE 1  
ROAD CLOSURES

(A) from 11:30 hours to 15:00 hours on:

(i) **Horse Wynd**; and (ii) **Queen's Drive**, from its junction with Horse Wynd, southwards for a distance of 160 metres or thereby (*to the roundabout*); and

(B) from 12:30 hours to 15:30 hours on:

(i) **Canongate**; (ii) **High Street**; (iii) **Lawnmarket**, between its junction with High Street and its junction with George IV Bridge; (iv) **Bristo Place**; (v) **Potterrow**; (vi) **Marshall Street**; (vii) **Crichton Street**; (viii) **Chapel Street**, between its junction with West Nicolson Street and its junction with Crichton Street; (ix) **Charles Street**; and (x) **George Square, north leg** in its entirety.

SCHEDULE 3  
PROHIBITION OF WAITING, LOADING & UNLOADING

From 08:30 hours to 15:30 hours on:

(i) **Holyrood Road, north side**, between its junction with Hammerman's Entry and its junction with Gentle's Entry (*except event vehicles*); (ii) **Abbey Strand**; (iii) **Horse Wynd**; (iv) **Canongate**; (v) **High Street**; (vi) **Lawnmarket, both sides**, between its junction with High Street and its junction with George IV Bridge; (vii) **George IV Bridge**; (viii) **Forrest Road, both sides**, between its junction with George IV Bridge and its junction with Bristo Place; (ix) **Bristo Place**; (x) **Potterrow**; (xi) **Marshall Street**; (xii) **Crichton Street**; (xiii) **Chapel Street, both sides**, between its junction with West Nicolson Street and its junction with Crichton Street; (xiv) **Charles Street**; and (xv) **George Square (east leg only), both sides**, between its junction with Crichton Street and its junction with Windmill Street.
