THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (HOLYROOD WEEK & VARIOUS EVENTS)  
(TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2024 –  
TEMP/24/108

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as amended, and of all other enabling powers being satisfied that traffic on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedules hereto should be prohibited or restricted to facilitate the holding of Holyrood Week & Various Events and to enable members of the public to watch this event and being satisfied that it is not reasonably practicable for the event to be held otherwise than on a road and having had regard to the safety and convenience of alternative routes suitable for traffic which will be affected by this Order, with the consent of the Scottish Ministers under Sections 16B(1)(b) and 16B(6)(b) of the said Act, hereby make the following Order: -

1. The Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (Holyrood Week & Various Events) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2024”. The order shall have effect during the hours and on the dates specified in the Schedules to this Order.
2. (a) In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:  
“Article” means an Article of this Order;  
“emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire or police purposes;  
“event vehicle” means any vehicle authorised by The City of Edinburgh Council as being connected with the event/s;  
“motor vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the 1984 Act;  
“Parking Attendant” has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act;  
“road” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 and for the avoidance of doubt, for the purposes of this order, includes part of a road;  
“the 2018 Order” means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018; and  
“vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.  
(b) References in this Order to a disabled person, to a disabled person's badge, to a disabled person's vehicle and to a vehicle displaying a disabled person's badge in the relevant position shall be construed in accordance with the 1984 Act, The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Scotland) Regulations 2000 and The Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (Scotland) Regulations 2002.
3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, to facilitate the holding of Holyrood Week & Various Events (as signed as affected by the event/s), no person shall:-
  - (a) drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on the section of road described in Schedule 1 hereto;
  - (b) cause or permit any motor vehicle to enter, proceed or wait in or on any part of the sections of roads specified in Schedule 2 hereto, where prohibitions will apply to roads in their entirety unless otherwise stated;
  - (c) drive or cause or permit any motor vehicle to be driven on the section of road specified in column 1 of Schedule 3 hereto, otherwise than in the direction specified opposite in the corresponding line of column 2 of the said Schedule;

- (d) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the sections of roads specified in Schedule 4 hereto, where restrictions will apply to both sides of the roads in their entirety unless otherwise stated;
  - (e) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle on the sections of the roads described in Schedule 5 hereto, where prohibitions will apply to both sides of the roads in their entirety unless otherwise stated.
4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to event vehicles or emergency service vehicles.
  5. Nothing in Article 3(d) shall apply:-
    - (a) to motor vehicles being driven or used by disabled persons and which conspicuously display, so as to be clearly visible from the front of the vehicle, a valid disabled person's badge;
    - (b) so as to prevent any person from causing or permitting a liveried vehicle to wait while the vehicle is in actual use for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or while loading or unloading the vehicle at premises adjoining the said road; provided that:
      - (i) no such vehicle so engaged shall wait for a period of more than thirty minutes in the same place; and
      - (ii) no such vehicle so engaged shall return to the same place, unless a period of more than thirty minutes has elapsed since the termination of the previous waiting period.
  6. The 2018 Order will be suspended in so far as it is affected by the restrictions specified in Article 3(e) of this Order.
  7. 'The City of Edinburgh Council (Castlehill) (Temporary Road Restrictions and Traffic Regulation) Order 2024' will be suspended ***between 07:30 hours and 09:00 hours on 28/06/2024; between 07:30 hours and 10:30 hours on 29/06/2024; and between 09:30 hours and 13:00 hours on 03/07/2024***, to facilitate the events.
  8. 'The City of Edinburgh Council (Various Roads, Edinburgh) (20 MPH Speed Limit) Order 2016' will be suspended ***between 00:30 hours and 15:00 hours on 29/06/2024*** in relation to the *one-way restriction* on **Abbeyhill Crescent**, to facilitate vehicular access to/from Calton Road.
  9. 'The Corporation of Edinburgh (Traffic Regulation, Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading and Parking Places) Order 1973' will be suspended ***between 09:30 hours and 13:00 hours on 03/07/2024*** in relation to the *one-way restriction* on **Cockburn Street**, to facilitate two-way access.
  10. 'The City of Edinburgh Council (High Street, Edinburgh) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Traffic Regulation Order 2001' will be suspended ***between 06:00 hours and 09:00 hours on 28/06/2024; between 07:00 hours and 10:30 hours on 29/06/2024; and between 09:30 hours and 13:00 hours on 03/07/2024***, to facilitate vehicular access to High Street.
  11. 'The City of Edinburgh Council (Johnston Terrace, Edinburgh) (Bus Priority Lane and One-Way) (Traffic Regulation) Order 2001' and 'The City of Edinburgh Council (Central Edinburgh) (Prohibition of Entry and Turning, One-Ways roads and Bus Lanes) Traffic Regulation Order 2004' will be suspended ***between 09:30 hours and 13:00 hours on 03/07/2024*** in relation to the *eastbound bus, taxi and cycle lane* on **Johnston Terrace**, to facilitate two-way traffic.

12. 'The Edinburgh Corporation (Blair Street, Niddry Street and Blackfriars Street (One-Way) (Variation) Order 1973' will be suspended **between 09:30 hours and 13:00 hours on 03/07/2024** in relation to the *one-way restriction* on **Niddry Street**, to facilitate vehicular access to/from Cowgate.

13. The alternative route for through vehicular traffic will be by way of: London Road, Leith Walk, York Place, Queen Street, St. Colme Street, Ainslie Place, Great Stuart Street, Randolph Crescent, Drumsheugh Place, Drumsheugh Gardens, Chester Street, Palmerston Place, Torphichen Street, Dewar Place, Morrison Street, Lothian Road, Earl Grey Street, Brougham Street, Melville Drive, Summerhall Crescent, Sciennes, Sciennes House Place, Causewayside, West Preston Street, East Preston Street, Dalkeith Road, Blackett Avenue, Minto Street, Mayfield Gardens, Craigmillar Park, Liberton Road, Gilmerton Road, Kingston Avenue, Old Dalkeith Road, Craigmillar Castle Road, Duddingston Road West and Willowbrae Road.

(B) *from 07:00 hours on 26/06/2024 to 05:59 hours on 28/06/2024; from 09:01 hours on 28/06/2024 to 00:29 hours on 29/06/2024; from 15:01 hours on 29/06/2024 to 12:59 hours on 02/07/2024; and from 19:01 hours on 02/07/2024 to 16:00 hours on 05/07/2024 on:*

**Horse Wynd**;

(C) *from 13:00 hours to 19:00 hours on 02/07/2024 on:*

**Holyrood Gait** (except local access and drop-off/collection of event related guests);

(D) *from 00:01 hours to 08:00 hours on 28/06/2024; and from 00:01 hours on 29/06/2024 to 17:00 hours on 04/07/2024 on:*

**St John Street**, from its junction with Canongate, southwards for a distance of 50 metres or thereby;

(E) *from 06:00 hours to 09:00 hours on 28/06/2024; from 07:00 hours to 10:30 hours on 29/06/2024; and from 09:30 hours to 13:00 hours on 03/07/2024 on:*

(i) **Castlehill**; and (ii) **Lawnmarket**;

(F) from 06:00 hours to 09:00 hours on 28/06/2024; and from 07:00 hours to 10:30 hours on 29/06/2024 on:

**High Street;**

(G) from 09:30 hours to 13:00 hours on 03/07/2024 on:

**High Street:** (1) between its junction with Lawnmarket and its junction with North/South Bridge; and (2) between its junction with North/South Bridge and its junction with Canongate;

(H) from 06:00 hours to 09:00 hours on 28/06/2024; from 00:30 hours to 15:00 hours on 29/06/2024; and from 10:00 hours to 13:00 hours on 03/07/2024 on:

**Canongate;**

(I) from 00:30 hours to 15:00 hours on 29/06/2024 on:

(i) **Queen’s Drive**, from the extended southern kerbline of Horse Wynd, southwards to the northmost roundabout on Queen’s Drive; (ii) **Cranston Street**; (iii) **New Street**, between its junction with Canongate and its junction with East Market Street; (iv) **Old Tolbooth Wynd**, from its junction with Canongate, northwards for a distance of 50 metres or thereby; (v) **Galloway’s Entry**; (vi) **Brown’s Close**; (vii) **Reid’s Court**; (viii) **Dunbar’s Close**; (ix) **Sugarhouse Close**; (x) **Gladstone’s Court/Bowling Green Court**; (xi) **Abbeyhill/Watergate**, between its junction with Canongate and its junction with Calton Road; and (xii) **Croft-an-Righ**; and

(J) from 09:30 hours to 13:00 hours on 03/07/2024 on:

(i) **King’s Bridge**; (ii) **Castle Wynd North Steps**; (iii) **Johnston Terrace**; (iv) **Upper Bow**; (v) **St Giles’ Street** (except access to rear of High Court); (vi) **Ramsay Lane**; (vii) **Ramsay Garden**; (viii) **Mound Place**; (ix) **West Parliament Square**; and (x) **Parliament Square**.

(i) **Abbey Strand**; (ii) **North Approach**; (iii) **Abbeyhill, both sides**, between its junction with Canongate and its junction with Croft-an-Righ; (iv) **Croft-an-Righ**; (v) **Canongate, both sides**, from its junction with Abbeyhill, westwards for a distance of 50 metres or thereby (*including taxi rank*); and (vi) **Horse Wynd**: (1) *west/south side*, in its entirety; and (2) *east/north side*: (i) from its junction with Abbey Strand/Canongate, southwards to the northmost extremity of the disabled person's parking bays; and (ii) from the southernmost extremity of the disabled person's parking bays, generally southwards to the point where Horse Wynd joins Queen's Drive;

(C) *from 18:00 hours on 28/06/2024 to 15:00 hours on 29/06/2024; from 15:30 hours to 17:30 hours on 01/07/2024; and from 07:00 hours to 19:00 hours on 02/07/2024* on:

**Horse Wynd, east side**, in its entirety;

(D) *from 18:30 hours on 27/06/2024 to 17:00 hours on 04/07/2024* on:

**St John Street, both sides**, from its junction with Canongate, southwards for a distance of 50 metres or thereby;

(E) *from 18:00 hours on 28/06/2024 to 18:30 hours on 29/06/2024; and from 07:00 hours to 19:00 hours on 02/07/2024* on:

(i) **Holyrood Gait** and (ii) **Holyrood Road**;

(F) *from 18:00 hours on 28/06/2024 to 15:00 hours on 29/06/2024; and from 07:00 hours to 19:00 hours on 02/07/2024* on:

**Abbey Mount**;

(G) *from 07:00 hours to 18:00 hours on 29/06/2024* on:

**Regent Road, both sides**, from its junction with Abbey Mount, westwards for a distance of 168 metres or thereby;

(H) *from 06:00 hours to 15:00 hours on 29/06/2024* on:

**Abbeyhill Crescent, east/south side**, in its entirety;

(I) *from 18:00 hours on 28/06/2024 to 15:00 hours on 29/06/2024* on:

(i) **Calton Road, both sides**, between its junction with Abbeyhill and its junction with Lochend Close; and (ii) **New Street, both sides**, between its junction with Canongate and its junction with East Market Street;

(J) *from 07:00 hours on 25/06/2024 to 16:00 hours on 05/07/2024* on:

**Holyrood Park Road, north-west side (layby)**, from its junction with Dalkeith Road, north-eastwards for a distance of 74 metres or thereby;

(K) *from 07:00 hours to 19:00 hours on 02/07/2024* on:

**Holyrood Park Road**: (1) *north-west side*, from a point 74 metres or thereby north-west of its junction with Dalkeith Road, north-eastwards to the entrance of Holyrood Park; and (2) *south-east side*, in its entirety;

(L) *from 07:00 hours to 19:00 hours on 02/07/2024* on:

**High Street, both sides**, between its junction with South Gray's Close and its junction with St Mary's Street;

(M) *from 06:00 hours to 09:00 hours on 28/06/2024; from 18:00 hours on 28/06/2024 to 00:00 hours on 29/06/2024; from 09:01 hours to 10:30 hours on 29/06/2024; and from 07:00 hours to 13:00 hours on 03/07/2024* on:

**High Street;**

(N) *from 06:00 hours to 09:00 hours on 28/06/2024; from 18:00 hours on 28/06/2024 to 00:00 hours on 29/06/2024; from 09:01 hours to 10:30 hours on 29/06/2024; and from 07:00 hours to 13:00 hours on 03/07/2024 on:*

(i) **Castlehill**; and (ii) **Lawnmarket**;

(O) *from 07:00 hours to 19:00 hours on 02/07/2024; and from 07:00 hours to 13:00 hours on 03/07/2024 on:*

**Canongate;**

(P) *from 18:30 hours on 28/06/2024 to 15:00 hours on 29/06/2024 on:*
