# Licensing Sub-Committee of the Regulatory Committee

#### **Present**

#### 1. Order of Business

An additional report – House in Multiple Occupation Licence Application - Flat 5, 38 Barony Street – Report by the Head of Regulatory Services was ruled urgent by the Convener in order for it to be considered as part of the agenda for this meeting.

## 2. Brunstane Road and Coillesdene Area Traffic Regulation Order and Redetermination Order

Details were provided of objections received during the formal advertising of a Traffic Regulation Order (TRO/23/14) and committee was asked to determine whether or not to proceed to make the order since more than six objections were received.
