THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (HEART OF MIDLOTHIAN 150<sup>th</sup> ANNIVERSARY PARADE) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2024 – TEMP/24/131

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act"), as amended, and of all other enabling powers being satisfied that traffic on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedules hereto should be prohibited or restricted to facilitate the holding of the Heart of Midlothian 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Parade and to enable members of the public to watch this event and being satisfied that it is not reasonably practicable for the event to be held otherwise than on a road and having had regard to the safety and convenience of alternative routes suitable for traffic which will be affected by this Order, with the consent of the Scottish Ministers under section 16B(6)(b) of the said Act, hereby make the following Order: -

- 1. The Order may be cited as "The City of Edinburgh Council (Heart of Midlothian 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Parade) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2024". The order shall have effect on the Thirteenth day of July Two thousand and twenty-four, during the hours specified in the Schedules to this Order.
- 2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them: "Article" means an Article of this Order;
  - "emergency service vehicle" means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire and rescue or police purposes;
  - "event vehicle" means any vehicle authorised by The City of Edinburgh Council as being connected with the event;
  - "motor vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the 1984 Act;
  - "Parking Attendant" has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act;
  - "road" has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 and for the avoidance of doubt, for the purposes of this order, includes part of a road;
  - "the 2018 Order" means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018; and
  - "vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
- 3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, to facilitate the Heart of Midlothian 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Parade event (as signed as affected by the event), no person shall:-
  - (a) drive or cause or permit any vehicle to be driven on the sections of roads specified in Schedule 1 hereto;
  - (b) drive or cause or permit any motor vehicle to be driven on the length of road specified in column 1 of Schedule 2 hereto, otherwise than in the direction specified opposite in the corresponding line of column 2 of the said Schedule; and
  - (c) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle on the sections of roads specified in Schedule 3 hereto.
- 4. Nothing in:
  - (a) Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles;
  - (b) Article 3(c) shall apply to event vehicles.

- 5. The 2018 Order will be suspended in so far as it is affected by the restrictions specified in Article 3(c) of this Order.
- 6. 'The City of Edinburgh Council (Greenways) Order 1997' will be suspended between 06:00 hours and 14:30 hours in relation to: (1) no stopping/no stopping at any time restrictions on the affected sections of Dalry Rd/Gorgie Rd; & between 12:00 hours and 14:30 hours in relation to: (2) prohibited turns from Gorgie Road into Robertson Avenue, Slateford Road into Roberston Avenue and Slateford Road into Stewart Terrace, to facilitate the event and to allow general traffic flow into the roads described above.
- 7. The alternative route for through vehicular traffic will be by way of Robertson Avenue, Slateford Road, Angle Park Terrace, Dundee Street, West Approach Road and Morrison Link.

## SCHEDULE 1 ROAD CLOSURE

From 12:00 hours to 14:30 hours on:

(i) **Morrison Street**, between its junction with Torphichen Place/Morrison Link and its junction with Dalry Road/West Maitland Street; (ii) **Dalry Road**, in its entirety; (iii) **Gorgie Road**, between the point where it adjoins Dalry Road and its junction with Newton Street; and (iv) **McLeod Street**, in its entirety.

(i) **Morrison Street**, *both sides*, between its junction with Torphichen Place/Morrison Link and its junction with Dalry Road/West Maitland Street; (ii) **Dalry Road**, *both sides*, in its entirety; and (iii) **Gorgie Road**, *both sides*, between the point where it adjoins Dalry Road and its junction with Newton Street.
