THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (WALTER SCOTT AVENUE AREA) (NO. 2)
(TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2024 –
TEMP/24/126

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (Walter Scott Avenue Area) (No. 2) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2024”. The order shall have effect on the Twenty-ninth day of July Two thousand and twenty-four and shall remain in force up to and including the Thirtieth day of October Two thousand and twenty-four.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:
“Article” means an Article of this Order;
“emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire and rescue or police purposes;
“Parking Attendant” has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act;
“the 2018 Order” means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018; and
“vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
3. Save as provided in Article 4, to facilitate footway resurfacing works (as signed as affected by the works), no person shall *between 7am-7pm Monday-Friday*:
 - (a) drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on: (i) **Walter Scott Avenue**: (1) at its junction with Gilmerton Road; and (2) at its junction with Old Dalkeith Road; (ii) **Ravenswood Avenue**, at its junction with Walter Scott Avenue; (iii) **Ashton Grove**, at both of its junctions with Walter Scott Avenue; (iv) **Dinmont Drive**, at both of its junctions with Walter Scott Avenue; (v) **Fairford Gardens**, at its junction with Walter Scott Avenue; (vi) **Balderston Gardens North**, at its junction with Walter Scott Avenue; (vii) **Ruthven Place**, at its junction with Walter Scott Avenue; (viii) **Bellenden Gardens**, at both of its junctions with Walter Scott Avenue; (ix) **Dundrennan Cottages**, at its junction with Walter Scott Avenue; and (x) **Hazelwood Grove**, at its junction with Walter Scott Avenue, provided that no more than one of the measures described in this section shall be enacted at any time; and
 - (b) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle on **Walter Scott Avenue, both sides**, between its junction with Gilmerton Road and its junction with Old Dalkeith Road.
4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles in actual use with the undertaking of the works.
5. The 2018 Order will be suspended in so far as it is affected by the restrictions specified in Article 3(b) of this Order.

6. The alternative routes for through vehicular traffic will be by way of: (i) **Walter Scott Avenue**: (1) and (2) – Gilmerton Road, Kingston Avenue and Old Dalkeith Road; or Gilmerton Road, Liberton Road, Lady Road, Cameron Toll and Old Dalkeith Road; (ii) **Ravenswood Avenue** – Redgauntlet Terrace and Gilmerton Road; (iii) **Ashton Grove** – Balderston Gardens, Ravenswood Avenue, Redgauntlet Terrace and Gilmerton Road; (iv) **Dinmont Drive** – Durward Grove, Hazeldean Terrace, Marmion Crescent, Glenallan Drive and Gilmerton Road; (v) **Fairford Gardens** – Dinmont Drive, Durward Grove, Hazeldean Terrace, Marmion Crescent, Glenallan Drive and Gilmerton Road; (vi) **Balderston Gardens North** – Balderston Gardens, Ravenswood Avenue, Redgauntlet Terrace and Gilmerton Road; (vii) **Bellenden Gardens** – Ravenswood Avenue, Redgauntlet Terrace and Gilmerton Road; (viii) **Dundrennan Cottages** – Dinmont Drive, Durward Grove, Hazeldean Terrace, Marmion Crescent, Glenallan Drive and Gilmerton Road; and (ix) **Hazelwood Grove** – Ravenswood Avenue, Redgauntlet Terrace and Gilmerton Road.
7. There is no available diversion with respect to the *closure* of **Ruthven Place**, where local access will be maintained.
8. ‘The City of Edinburgh Council (Walter Scott Avenue Area) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2024’ is hereby revoked.
