THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (EIF OPENING EVENT) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2024 – TEMP/24/132

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (EIF Opening Event) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2024”. The order shall have effect during the hours and on the dates specified in the Schedules to this Order.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:
“Article” means an Article of this Order;
“emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire and rescue or police purposes;
“event vehicle” means any vehicle authorised by the City of Edinburgh Council as being connected with the event;
“motor vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the 1984 Act;
“Parking Attendant” has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act;
“the 2018 Order” means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018; and
“vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
3. Save as provided in Article 4, to facilitate the EIF opening event (as signed as affected by the event), no person shall:-
 - (a) cause or permit any motor vehicle to enter, proceed or wait in or on any part of the length of road specified in Schedule 1 hereto; and
 - (b) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle on the sections of roads described in Schedule 2 hereto.
4. Nothing in:
 - (i) Article 3(a) shall apply to event vehicles; and
 - (ii) Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles.
5. The 2018 Order will be suspended in so far as it is affected by the restrictions specified in Article 3(b) of this Order.
6. The alternative route for through vehicular traffic will be way of Lauriston Place and Keir Street.

SCHEDULE 1
PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES

From 18:00 hours to 23:59 hours on 02/08/2024, 03/08/2024 and 04/08/2024 respectively on:
Heriot Place, in its entirety.

SCHEDULE 2
PROHIBITION OF WAITING, LOADING & UNLOADING

(A) from 07:00 hours on 26/07/2024 to 23:59 hours on 07/08/2024 on:
Lauriston Place, south side, from its junction with Nightingale Way, eastwards for a distance of 150 metres or thereby; and

(B) from 18:00 hours to 23:59 hours on 02/08/2024, 03/08/2024 and 04/08/2024 respectively on:
Lauriston Place: (1) **north side**, between its junction with Heriot Place and its junction with Forrest Road (*excluding taxi rank to the west of George Heriot's School Gate House*); and (2) **south side**, between its junction with Nightingale Way and its junction with Archibald Place.
