THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (ORCHARD DRIVE AREA) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2024 – TEMP/24/139

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -


1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (Orchard Drive Area) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2024”. The order shall have effect on the Twenty-ninth day of August Two thousand and twenty-four and shall remain in force up to and including the Twenty-eighth day of November Two thousand and twenty-four.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:
  - “Article” means an Article of this Order;
  - “emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire and rescue or police purposes;
  - “motor vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the 1984 Act;
  - “Parking Attendant” has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act;
  - “the 2018 Order” means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018; and
  - “vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
3. Save as provided in Article 4, to facilitate swale construction and sustainable drainage infrastructure works (as signed as affected by the works), no person shall:-
  - (a) drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on **Orchard Drive**, from its junction with Queensferry Road, eastwards to the projected east property boundary of No. 58 Orchard Drive; or
  - (b) drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle on **Orchard Drive**, between its junction with Queensferry Road and its junction with Orchard Crescent, otherwise than in an *eastbound* direction, provided that no more than one of the measures described in Article 3(a) or (b) are enacted at any time; and
  - (c) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle at any time on *both sides* of: (i) **Orchard Crescent**, in its entirety; and (ii) **Orchard Drive**, from its junction with Queensferry Road, eastwards to the projected east property boundary of No. 22 Orchard Drive.
4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles in actual use with the undertaking of the works.
5. The 2018 Order will be suspended in so far as it is affected by the restrictions specified in Article 3(c) of this Order.

6. The alternative route for through vehicular traffic with respect to the *road closure* and *one-way restriction* is via Orchard Ter, Orchard Rd & Queensferry Rd.
