THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (SCOTLAND VS AUSTRALIA T20 TESTS)
(TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2024 –
TEMP/24/155

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 62 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984, as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (Scotland vs Australia T20 Tests) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2024”. The order shall have effect during the hours and on the dates specified in the Schedules to this Order.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:
 - “Article” means an Article of this Order;
 - “emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire and rescue or police purposes;
 - “event vehicle” means any vehicle authorised by City of Edinburgh Council as being connected with the event;
 - “motor vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;
 - “Parking Attendant” has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;
 - “Schedule” means a Schedule to this Order;
 - “the 2018 Order” means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018; and
 - “vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
3. Save as provided in Article 4, to facilitate site safety relating to the cricket event (as signed as affected by the event/s), no person shall:-
 - (a) cause or permit any motor vehicle to enter, proceed or wait on the section of road specified in Schedule 1 hereto; and
 - (b) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle on the section of road specified in Schedule 2 hereto.
4. Nothing in:
 - (i) Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles
 - (ii) Article 3(a) shall apply to event vehicles.
5. The 2018 Order will be suspended in so far as it is affected by the restrictions specified in Article 3(b) of this Order.

6. There is no alternative route with respect to the *prohibition of motor vehicles* on **Portgower Place**, where local access will be maintained.

SCHEDULE 1
PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES

From 06:00 hours to 20:00 hours on 26/08/2024 and 09/09/2024 respectively on:

Portgower Place, from a point 100 metres or thereby north of the extended northern kerbline of Comely Bank Road/Raeburn Place, northwards to the northernmost point of the cul-de-sac.

SCHEDULE 2
PROHIBITION OF WAITING, LOADING & UNLOADING

From 08:00 hours to 18:00 hours DAILY from 26/08/2024 to 09/09/2024 on:

Portgower Place, both sides, from a point 60 metres or thereby north of the extended northern kerbline of Comely Bank Road/Raeburn Place, northwards for a distance of 70 metres or thereby.
