
THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (MOONWALK 2024) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2024 – TEMP/24/159

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as amended, and of all other enabling powers being satisfied that traffic on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedules hereto should be prohibited or restricted to facilitate the holding of the Moonwalk 2024 event, and to enable members of the public to watch this event and being satisfied that it is not reasonably practicable for the event to be held otherwise than on a road and having had regard to the safety and convenience of alternative routes suitable for traffic which will be affected by this Order, with the consent of the Scottish Ministers under sections 16B(1)(b) and 16B(6)(b) of the said Act, hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (Moonwalk 2024) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2024”. The order shall have effect during the hours and on the dates specified in the Schedules to this Order.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:
 - “Article” means an Article of this Order;
 - “emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire and rescue or police purposes;
 - “event vehicle” means any vehicle authorised by City of Edinburgh Council as being connected with the event;
 - “motor vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the 1984 Act;
 - “Parking Attendant” has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act;
 - “Schedule” means a Schedule to this Order;
 - “the 2018 Order” means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2018; and
 - “vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
3. Save as provided in Article 4, to facilitate the holding of the Moonwalk 2024 event (as signed as affected by the event), no person shall:-
 - (a) cause or permit any motor vehicle to enter, proceed or wait in or on any part of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 hereto, where prohibitions will apply to roads in their entirety unless otherwise stated; and
 - (b) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle on the sections of roads specified in Schedule 2 hereto, where prohibitions will apply to both sides of the roads in their entirety unless otherwise stated.
4. Nothing in:
 - (i) Article 3(a) shall apply to *event vehicles* on the sections of roads specified in Schedule 1 of this Order; and
 - (ii) Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles.

5. Whilst this order remains in force, 'The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading: West Area) (No. 1) Experimental Traffic Order 2022' and 'The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading: North Area) (No. 1) Experimental Traffic Order 2022' will be suspended **between 23:00 hours on 07/09/2024 and 10:00 hours on 08/09/2024** in relation to the **prohibition of motor vehicles** on **Silverknowes Road** and **West Shore Road** respectively, to allow full vehicular access to Moonwalk support vehicles in case of emergency.
6. The 2018 Order will be suspended in so far as it is affected by the restrictions specified in Article 3(b) of this Order.
7. The alternative route for through vehicular traffic with respect to the *prohibition of motor vehicles* will be by way of Dalkeith Road, Pleasance, St Mary's Street, Canongate, Abbeyhill, Abbey Mount, Montrose Terrace, London Road and Willowbrae Road (*Holyrood Park area*); and Queensferry Road, Craigcrook Road and Strachan Road (*Ravelston Dykes Road*).

SCHEDULE 1 PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES

(A) *from 22:30 hours on 07/09/2024 to 01:45 hours on 08/09/2024* on:

(i) **Holyrood Gait**; (ii) **Horse Wynd**; (iii) **Queen's Drive**; and (iv) **Duke's Walk**; and

(B) *from 23:30 hours on 07/09/2024 to 04:00 hours on 08/09/2024* on:

Ravelston Dykes Road.

SCHEDULE 2 PROHIBITION OF WAITING, LOADING & UNLOADING

From 08:00 hours on 07/09/2024 to 18:00 hours on 08/09/2024 on:

(i) **Holyrood Gait**; (ii) **Queen's Drive, both sides**: (1) from its junction with Holyrood Gait, north-eastwards to the roundabout leading to the north-to-south section of Queen's Drive & Horse Wynd; & (2) from the north-west and north-east kerblines of the roundabout leading to the north-to-south section of Queen's Drive & Horse Wynd, generally northwards for 135 metres or thereby; and (iii) **Horse Wynd.**
