Passing the assessment is a requirement prior to the grant of a Taxi or Private Hire Car Driver licence.

FAQ's

Information on this page may be a useful guide of what to expect on the day of the assessment.

1. How will the assessment be delivered?

- a. The assessment is completed in-person at the Licensing Hub, 33 Murrayburn Road Edinburgh, EH14 2TF

2. How long will the assessment last?

- a. The assessment will last for 45 minutes

3. Is the assessment open or closed book?

- a. The assessment is closed book - meaning you cannot refer to any books or notes and the use of phones or electronic devices are prohibited during the assessment

4. What type of questions are in the assessment?

- a. There are a series of multiple choice questions - based on subjects covered in the online presentations, the foundation course training workbook and licensing conditions documents

5. What is the pass mark for the assessment?

- a. You will need to achieve a score of 75% or more correct answers to pass

6. How long will it take to find out if I passed?

- a. The results will be communicated to you within 2 weeks

7. What happens if I pass the assessment?

- a. A certificate of achievement will be posted to the home address given on this booking form
- b. If you have submitted your Licence application, or at the time when you do so, the licensing database will be updated to record the successful completion of your training

8. What happens if I fail the assessment?

- a. You will have an opportunity to re-sit a different test at a future date
