### THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (GLASGOW ROAD (A8) & TURNHOUSE ROAD) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2024 – TEMP/24/191

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (Glasgow Road (A8) & Turnhouse Road) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2024”. The order shall have effect on the Second day of November Two thousand and twenty-four and shall remain in force up to and including the Twenty-ninth day of November Two thousand and twenty-four.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:  
“Article” means an Article of this Order;  
“emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire and rescue or police purposes;  
“motor vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the 1984 Act;  
“Parking Attendant” has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act; and  
“vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
3. Save as provided in Article 4, to facilitate carriageway resurfacing and drainage improvement works (as signed as affected by the works), no person shall:-
  - (a) drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle **between 7.30pm and 6.30am DAILY on Turnhouse Road**, from the extended north-western kerblines of West Craigs Crescent, eastwards to the extended western kerblines of Maybury Road;
  - (b) drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle **between 7:30pm and 6:30am DAILY on Glasgow Road (A8)**, from the extended western kerblines of Maybury Road, westwards to the point where the eastbound on-slip from Gogar Roundabout meets Glasgow Road (A8), otherwise than in a **westbound** direction; and
  - (c) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle at any time on **both sides** of: (i) **Glasgow Road (A8), both carriageways**, from the extended western kerblines of Maybury Road, eastwards to the point where the eastbound on-slip from Gogar Roundabout meets Glasgow Road (A8); and (ii) **Turnhouse Road**, from the extended north-western kerblines of West Craigs Crescent, eastwards to the extended western kerblines of Maybury Road.
4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles in actual use with the undertaking of the works.
5. The alternative route for through vehicular traffic with respect to the *closure* will be by way of Maybury Road, Craigs Road and Turnhouse Road.

6. The alternative route for through vehicular traffic with respect to the *one-way restriction* will be by way of Gogar Roundabout, Glasgow Road (A8) *westbound*, Ingliston Interchange and Glasgow Road (A8) *eastbound*.
