THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (HILLPARK AVENUE & ROAD) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2024 – TEMP/24/195

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (Hillpark Avenue & Road) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2024”. The order shall have effect on the Eighteenth day of November Two thousand and twenty-four and shall remain in force up to and including the Second day of December Two thousand and twenty-four.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:
“Article” means an Article of this Order;
“emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire and rescue or police purposes;
“Parking Attendant” has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act; and
“vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
3. Save as provided in Article 4, to facilitate a safe working area for Scottish Water sewer repair works (as signed as affected by the works), no person shall:-
 - (a) drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on **Hillpark Avenue**, from a point 20 metres or thereby north of the extended north-western kerbline of Hillpark Drive, northwards for a distance of 25 metres or thereby; and
 - (b) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle at any time on **both sides** of: (i) **Hillpark Avenue**, from a point 20 metres or thereby north of the extended north-western kerbline of Hillpark Drive, northwards for a distance of 25 metres or thereby; and (ii) **Hillpark Road**, from the projected west property boundary of No. 15 Hillpark Road, north-eastwards to the projected east property boundary of No. 9 Hillpark Road.
4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles in actual use with the undertaking of the works.
5. The alternative route for through vehicular traffic will be by way of Hillpark Avenue and Hillpark Road.
