



THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (ELLEN'S GLEN ROAD) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2025 – TEMP/25/08

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (Ellen’s Glen Road) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2025”. The order shall have effect on the Twenty-seventh day of January Two thousand and twenty-five and shall remain in force up to and including the Twenty-fifth day of April Two thousand and twenty-five.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:
“Article” means an Article of this Order;
“emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire and rescue or police purposes;
“Parking Attendant” has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the 1984 Act;
“the 2025 Order” means The City of Edinburgh Council (Traffic Regulation; Restrictions on Waiting, Loading and Unloading, Stopping and Parking Places) Designation and Traffic Regulation Order 2025; and
“vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
3. Save as provided in Article 4, to facilitate a safe working area for culvert repair works (as signed as affected by the works), no person shall:-
 - (a) drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle; or
 - (b) walk or cause or permit any person to walk on the footway on **Ellen’s Glen Road**, from the point the vehicular access to the staff only car park at Liberton Hospital meets Ellen’s Glen Road, north-eastwards to the bollards south-west of No. 25 Ellen’s Glen Road; and
 - (c) except with the permission of a Parking Attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load onto or unload from any vehicle at any time on **both sides** of **Ellen’s Glen Road**, from the extended north-eastern kerblines of Lasswade Road, north-eastwards to the projected south gable end of No. 25 Ellen’s Glen Road.
4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles in actual use with the undertaking of the works.
5. The 2025 Order will be suspended in so far as it is affected by the restrictions specified in Article 3(c) of this Order.
6. There is no available diversion with respect to **closure** of **Ellen’s Glen Road**, where local access will be maintained.
7. The alternative route for pedestrians will be by way of Ellen’s Glen Road, Lasswade Road, Malbet Park, Malbet Wynd, Stennis Gardens and Ellen’s Glen Road.
