DSDP Intermediate Training Course

The training course will consist of 8 units covered over 3 days; the training will be delivered face to face at the Licensing Hub at Murrayburn.

Training is mandatory and licence holders require to complete all three days training as part of the renewal process for their Taxi/PHC driver's licence.

Course fees

The fee for the Intermediate Course is £300 this also includes lunch and refreshments on each day. There will be an opportunity to complete an optional assessment at the end of this course, but this will not be mandatory.

Cancellations and Refunds

Please note there will be a £50 re-booking fee for any course cancellations with less than a 5 working days' notice.

All fees are payable at the time of lodging and are non-refundable except in exceptional circumstances.

On completion of the application form you will be sent a confirmation with dates of your course and approximately 7 days in advance of course start date you will receive a text/email reminder.

The Intermediate Course Training Workbook plus a copy of the Licensing Conditions for Taxi and Private Hire Cars and Drivers will be supplied on Day 1 of the course.

Training is specific to the Edinburgh Taxi and Private Hire industry, providing learners with the relevant provisions of the Civic Government (Scotland) Act 1982 as amended and licensing conditions. Training and written materials will be delivered in English.

DSDP Intermediate Training Course

This training program will deliver structured training for all existing Taxi and Private Hire Car drivers. It covers the core skills and knowledge that would be expected off existing Taxi and Private Hire drivers with a focus on safety, quality of service and compliance with local licensing conditions.
