Notice of Election ELECTIONS TO COMMUNITY COUNCILS Wednesday 5 February 2025

In accordance with the Scheme for Community Councils, elections will take place on 28 March 2025 to elect members to community councils in Edinburgh for a four-year term. Persons wishing to stand for election to their community council must be 16 years of age or older, reside in the community council area and be named on the electoral register for the community council area in which they are standing.

A candidate's proposer and seconder must also reside in the same local area and be named on the electoral register. Individuals may only propose one and second one candidate.

Completed nomination forms must be submitted to the Governance Team by 4pm on Thursday 27 February 2025. Only those persons whose names appear on the electoral register on 6 January 2025 will be eligible to stand and vote at these elections.
