THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (ALBANY LANE) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2025 – TEMP/25/15

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (Albany Lane) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2025”. The order shall have effect on the Twenty-fifth day of February Two thousand and twenty-five and shall remain in force up to and including the Twentieth day of March Two thousand and twenty-five.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:
“Article” means an Article of this Order;
“emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire and rescue or police purposes; and
“vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
3. Save as provided in Article 4, to facilitate a safe working area for Scottish Water sewer repair works (as signed as affected by the works), no person shall, drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on **Albany Lane**, between its junction with Barony Street and its junction with Albany Street Lane.
4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles in actual use with the undertaking of the works.
5. The alternative route for through vehicular traffic will be by way of Barony Street, Broughton Street and Albany Street.
