



THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL (HARRISON ROAD) (TEMPORARY ROAD RESTRICTION AND TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2025 – TEMP/25/39

THE CITY OF EDINBURGH COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14 (1) (b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), as amended, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf hereby make the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as “The City of Edinburgh Council (Harrison Road) (Temporary Road Restriction and Traffic Regulation) Order 2025”. The order shall have effect on the First day of April Two thousand and twenty-five and shall remain in force up to and including the Thirty-first day of October Two thousand and twenty-five.
2. In this Order the following phrases have the meanings respectively assigned to them:  
“Article” means an Article of this Order;  
“emergency service vehicle” means a vehicle being used for ambulance, fire and rescue or police purposes; and  
“vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 151 of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
3. Save as provided in Article 4, to facilitate bridge structural repair works (as signed as affected by the works), no person shall, drive or cause or permit to be driven any vehicle on **Harrison Road**: (1) from the projected rear building line of No. 20 Harrison Road, south-eastwards to the projected north-west building line of No. 57 Harrison Road; and (2) from the extended north-western kerbline of Polwarth Terrace, north-westwards for a distance of 60 metres or thereby.
4. Nothing in Article 3 shall apply to emergency service vehicles or vehicles in actual use with the undertaking of the works.
5. The alternative routes for through vehicular traffic will be by way of: (1) Laurel Terrace, Slateford Road (A70), Shandon Place, Ashley Terrace and Harrison Gardens; and (2) Polwarth Terrace, Ashley Terrace and Harrison Gardens.
