Notice of Temporary Road Closure – Iona Street

Expected Duration: Monday 9 November to Sunday 22 November 2020

As part of the project's traffic management arrangements there is fixed traffic management in place. However, in order to facilitate some of the works on the project, there are times where additional road closures will be required, these are approved by the City of Edinburgh Council Traffic Management Review Panel.

What will we be doing?

As part of our programme of works, we are scheduled to carry out drainage works within our work space. In order to facilitate these works we need to close off vehicle exiting from Iona Street on to Leith Walk. The anticipated duration of the closure is for **2-weeks**.

Pedestrian access will be maintained. Localised diversions will be in place with access via Dalmeny Street.

Diversion signage will remain in place for the duration of the road closure from the above dates. These signs will be mounted on standard verge located A frames and secured with ballasted sandbags.

Please be advised we will be working hard to ensure any impacts on residents / businesses are kept to a minimum during these and all future works.
