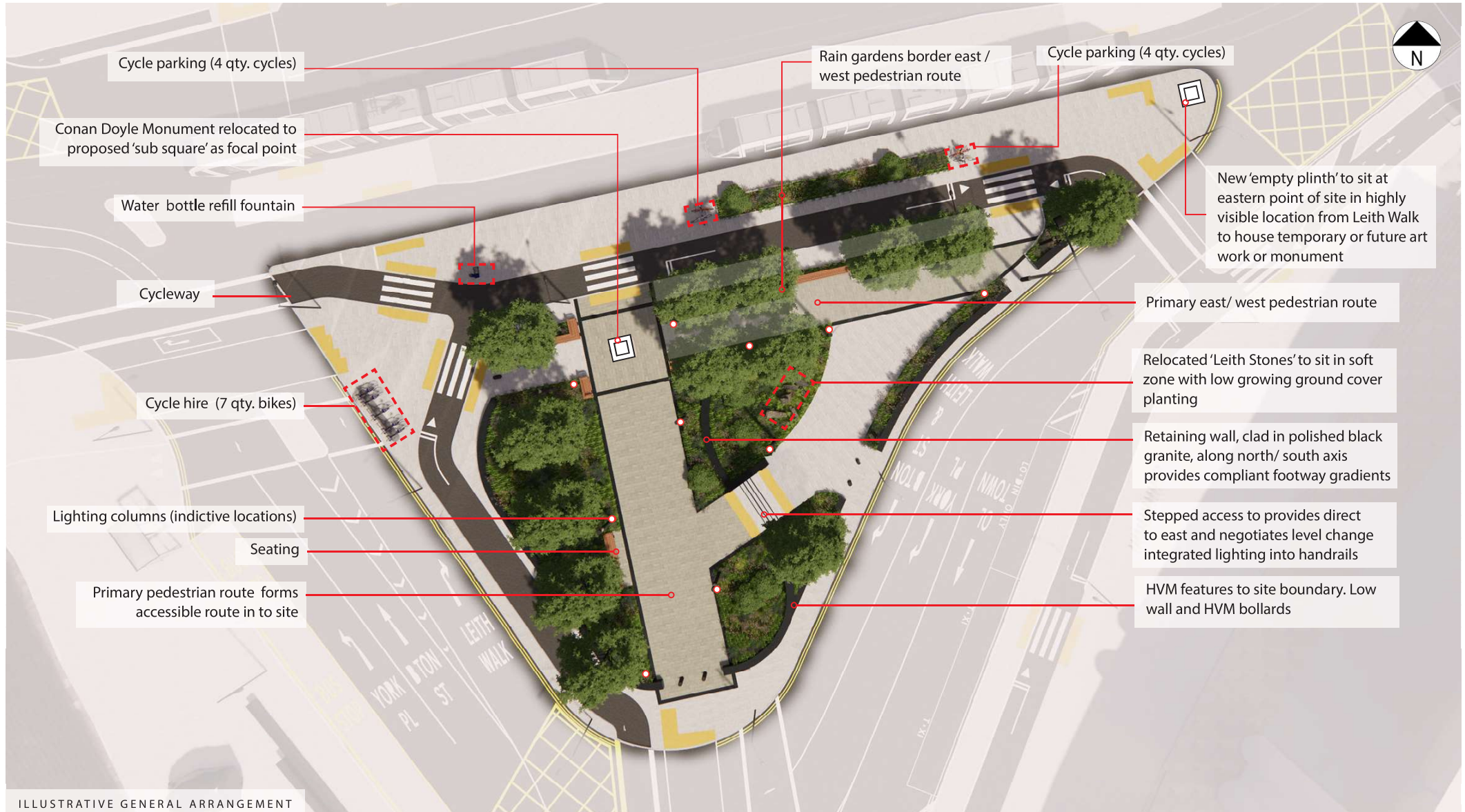


6.2 PUBLIC REALM GENERAL ARRANGEMENT



Cycle parking (4 qty. cycles)

Conan Doyle Monument relocated to proposed 'sub square' as focal point

Water bottle refill fountain

Cycleway

Cycle hire (7 qty. bikes)

Lighting columns (indicative locations)

Seating

Primary pedestrian route forms accessible route in to site

Rain gardens border east / west pedestrian route

Cycle parking (4 qty. cycles)

New 'empty plinth' to sit at eastern point of site in highly visible location from Leith Walk to house temporary or future art work or monument

Primary east/ west pedestrian route

Relocated 'Leith Stones' to sit in soft zone with low growing ground cover planting

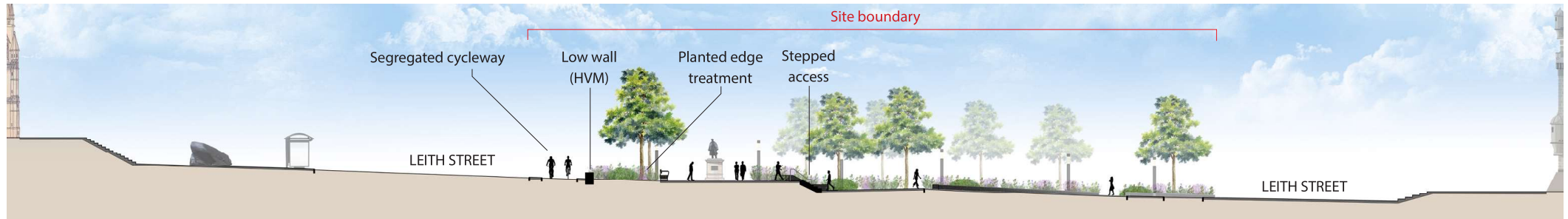
Retaining wall, clad in polished black granite, along north/ south axis provides compliant footway gradients

Stepped access to provides direct to east and negotiates level change integrated lighting into handrails

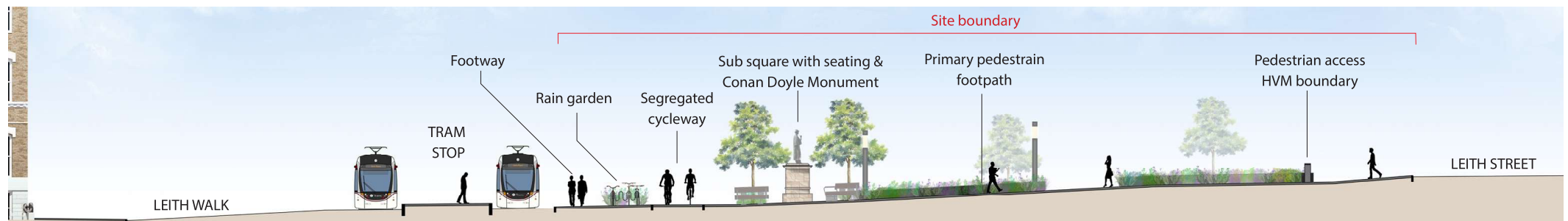
HVM features to site boundary. Low wall and HVM bollards



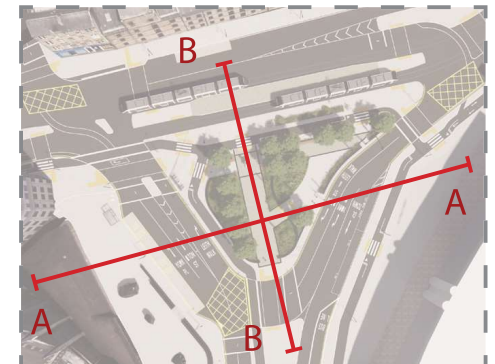

SITE SECTION A - A

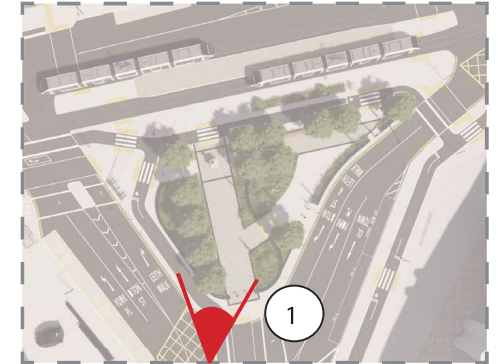


SITE SECTION B - B



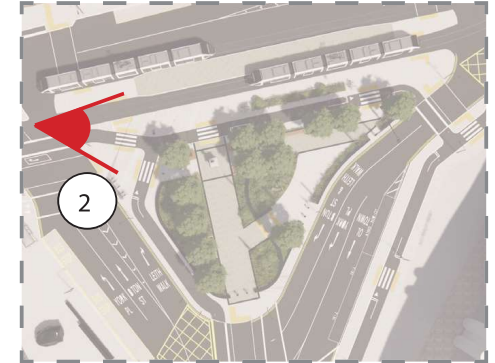

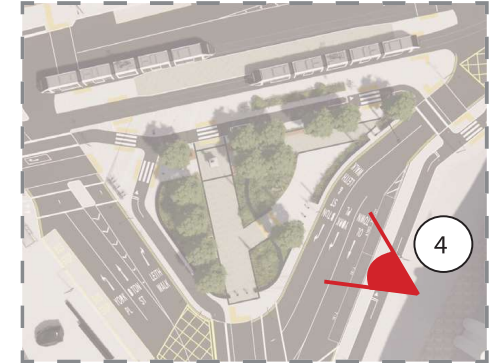

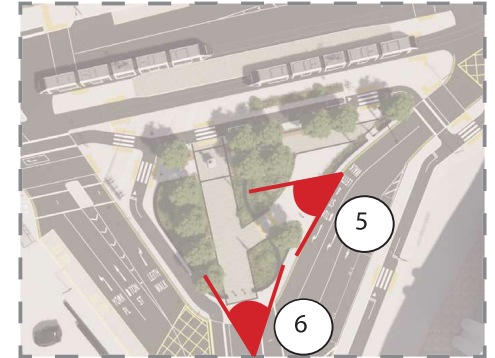


4 BIRDS EYE VIEW OF THE SITE FROM LEITH WALK LOOKING WEST

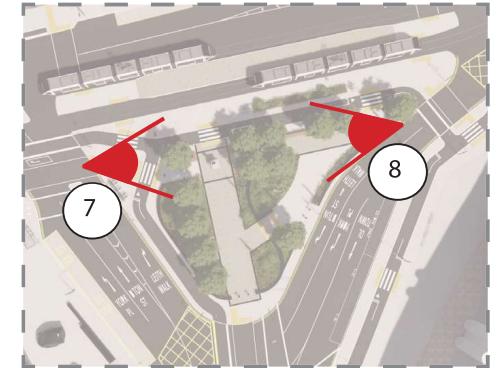

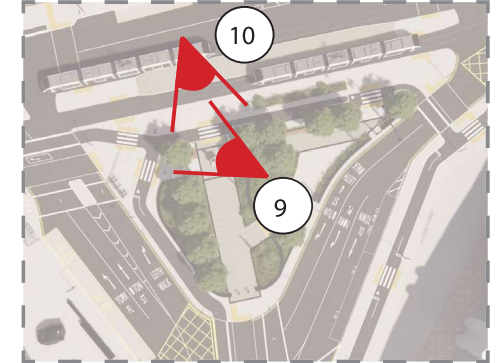
